## CLASS 1A DIVISION I AND CLASS 1A DIVISION II SCHOOLS

## Rule 5-2-1 (Classifications of Senior High Schools)

Class 1A schools shall compete in 2 separate divisions in volleyball, basketball and scholars bowl. Following the annual classification \& determination of schools assigned to Class 1A, the half of the schools with the larger enrollment will be assigned to Division I and the half with the smaller enrollment will be assigned to Division II. If there is an odd number of schools, Division I will be assigned more schools than Division II.
**Art. 2 If 2 or more schools have identical enrollments and are on the lower end of a Classification division, the school(s) having the higher enrollment the previous year shall be assigned to the higher classification/division.

## Rule 29 (Cooperative Agreement)

The Executive Board may allow 2 member schools to be combined for interscholastic activity competition and field a common participating group. Examples which constitute needs are: insufficient numbers, lack of staff, and lack of facilities. When combined to compete in a team sport, the classification appropriate for the combined enrollment of the schools involved will apply.

There are 115 1A schools for 2023-2024. There are nine cooperative agreements in basketball involving 1A schools. One cooperative moves those schools to Class 2A: Dexter/Cedar Vale (138). Howard-West Elk will remain 2A (139). The remaining cooperative agreements (marked with *) will remain in Class 1A. There are 104 boys teams. Lawrence-Bishop Seabury will sponsor a boys team only. There are 52 boys teams in each division. There are 103 girls teams. There are 52 girls teams in Division I and 51 girls teams in Division II. Moran-Marmaton Valley, Randolph-Blue Valley, Satanta and Tribune-Greeley County each have 71 students. Moran-Marmaton Valley had the most students (78) last year. Their girls will compete in Division I and their boys will compete in Division II
