IMPORTANT INFORMATION



TICKET SALES, CENTER ADMITTANCE:

▶ **General admission tickets will go on sale at the following times:**

7:15 AM	Thursday, March 1 (6A Boys Tournament)
12:30PM	Thursday, March 1 (6A Girls Tournament)
7:15 AM	Friday, March 2 (5-1A Boys Tournament)
12:30PM	Friday, March 2 (5-1A Girls Tournament)

NOTE: EACH TOURNAMENT WILL REQUIRE A SEPARATE TICKET

ADMISSION PRICE: Adults = \$7; Grades K-12 = \$6

- ▶ **SAVING SEATS FOR OTHERS IS NOT PERMITTED!**
- ▶ **LIMITED HANDICAPPED SEATING AVAILABLE.**
- ▶ **NOTE: DUE TO THE SIZE OF THE TOURNAMENT, SPECTATORS ARE NOT GUARANTEED A PLACE TO SIT.**

PASS GATE:

- ▶ **COMPETITORS FOR THE STATE TOURNAMENT WILL BE ADMITTED AT THE POSTED TIME (7:20 AM and 12:35 PM).** Only those listed on their school pass gate will be admitted at no charge to the state tournament.
- ▶ Teams are asked to enter as a group to expedite this process.
- ▶ State Bowlers will be admitted at no cost to another tournament IF ACCOMPANIED BY THEIR COACH.

OUTSIDE FOOD/DRINK NOT ALLOWED:

- ▶ Spectators **MAY NOT** bring outside food or drink into the Bowling Center.

NOISEMAKERS NOT ALLOWED:

- ▶ Noisemakers, confetti and glitter **ARE NOT ALLOWED IN THE BOWLING CENTER.**

CELL PHONES /ELECTRONIC DEVICES:

- ▶ Athletes may not be in possession of or use cell phones/electronic devices in competition area.
- ▶ Spectators are asked to refrain from using cell phones in the immediate spectator seating area.
- ▶ Spectator cell phones should be turned off, silenced or placed on vibrate.

COACHING BY SCHOOL COACH ONLY:

- ▶ Per KSHSAA rules, during competition bowlers may only be coached by their school coach.
- ▶ Bowlers who receive advice from anyone else are subject to disqualification.

FLASH PHOTOGRAPHY/PICTURES:

- ▶ Flash photography is not permitted during competition.
- ▶ Picture-taking opportunities will be available during & after the awards ceremony.
