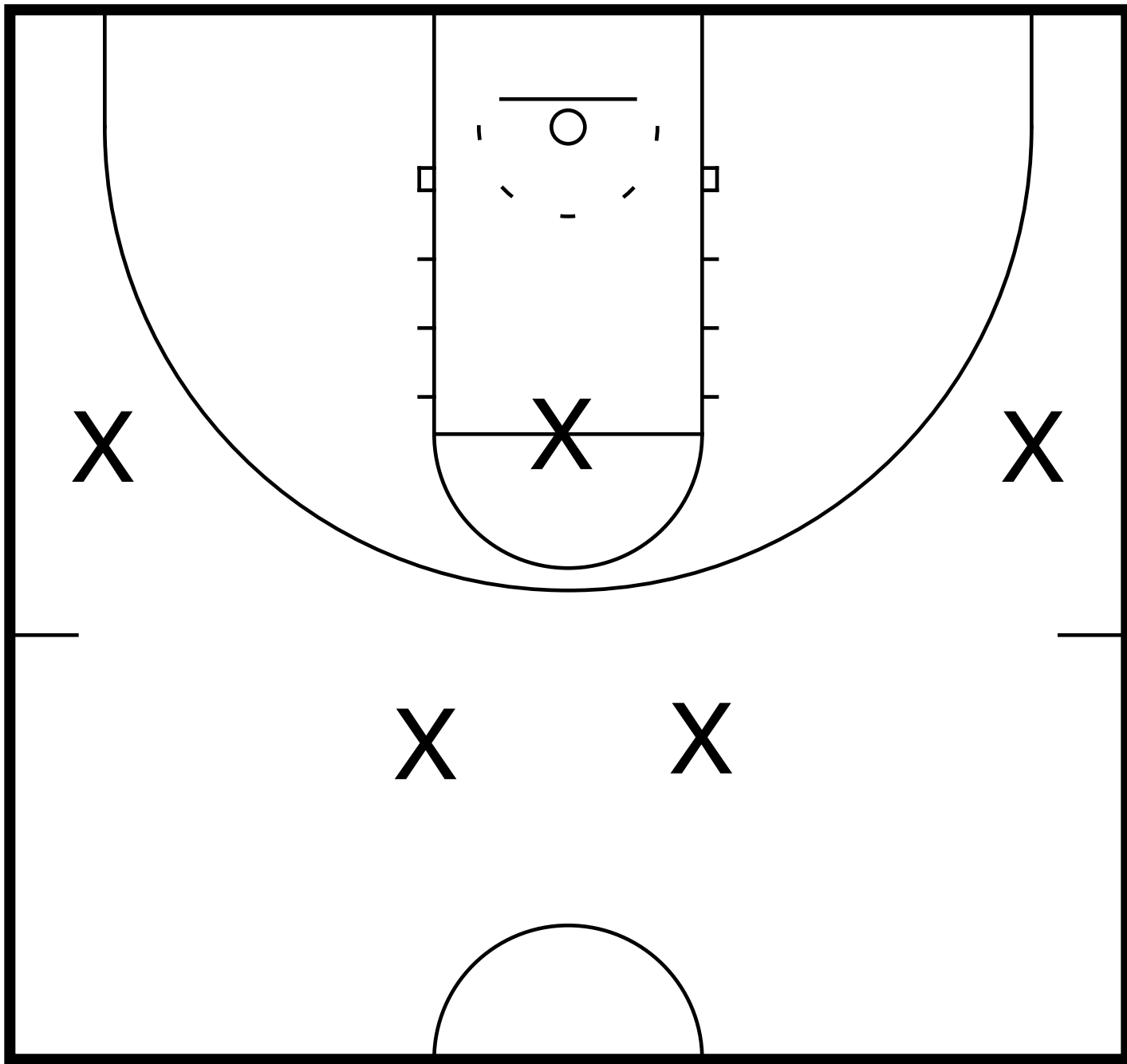
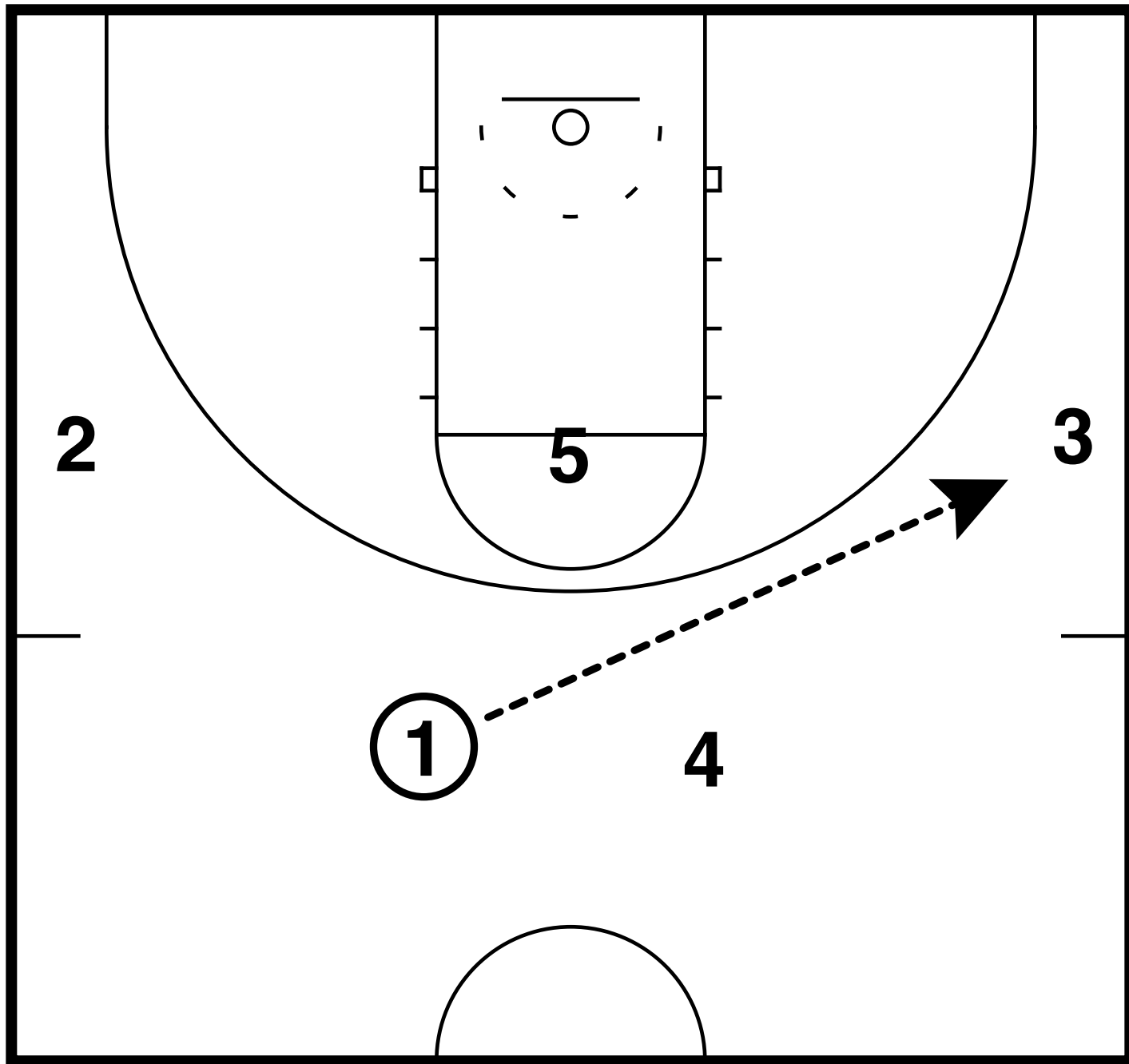


# Basic Action Spread



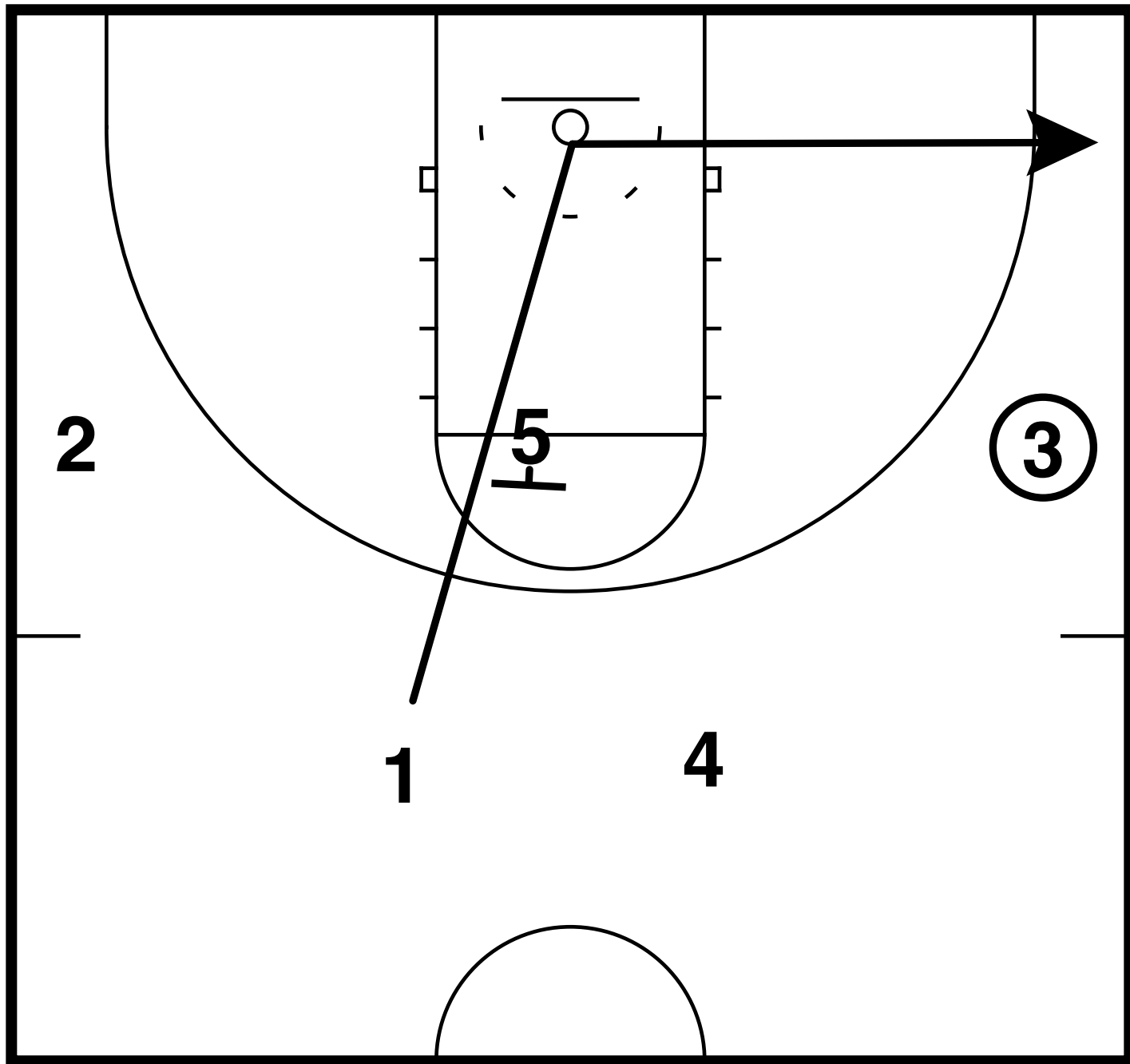
Spread Spots

### Basic Action Spread



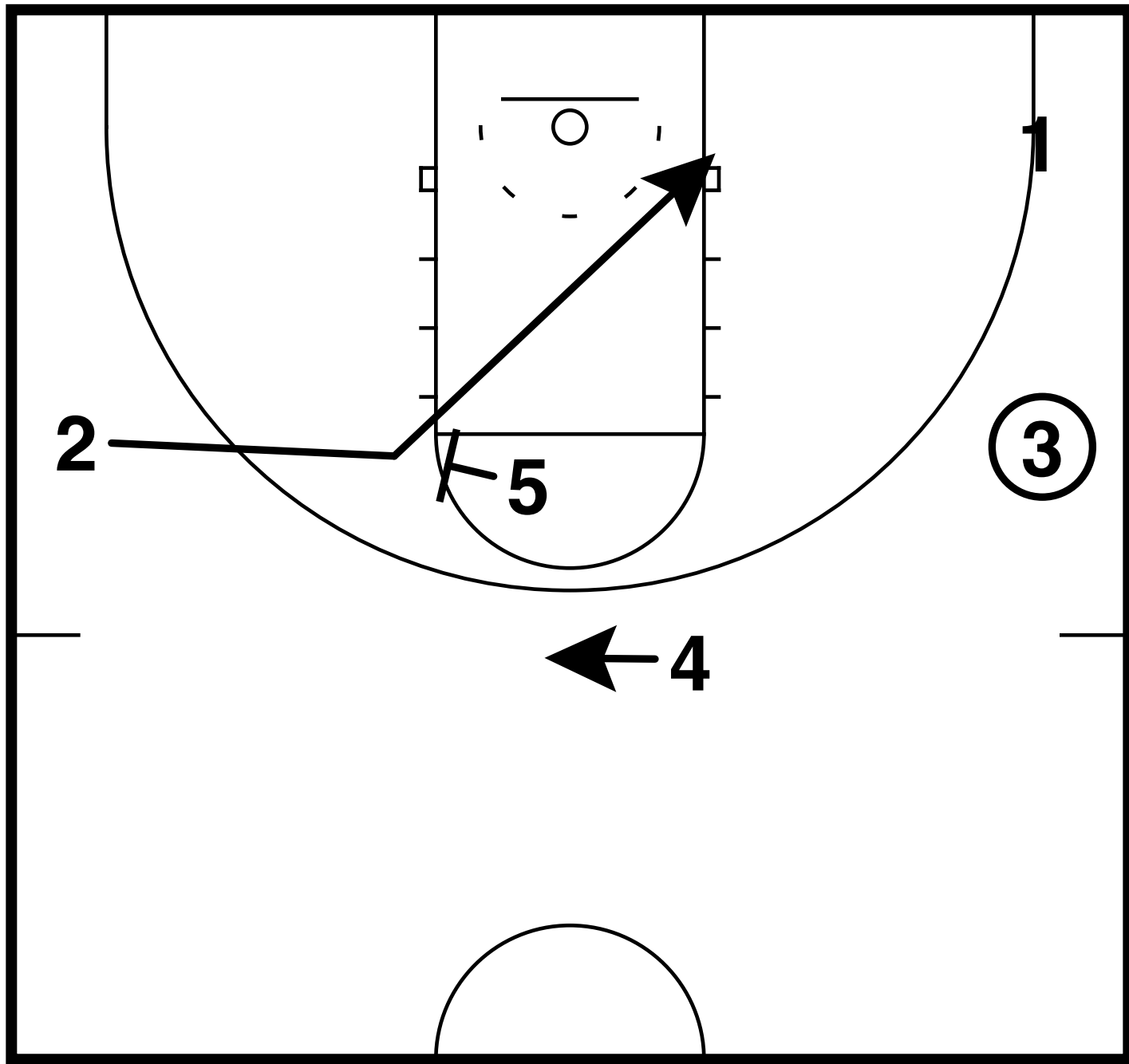
Anytime the ball hits the wing, you have opposite side first and second cutters.

### Basic Action Spread



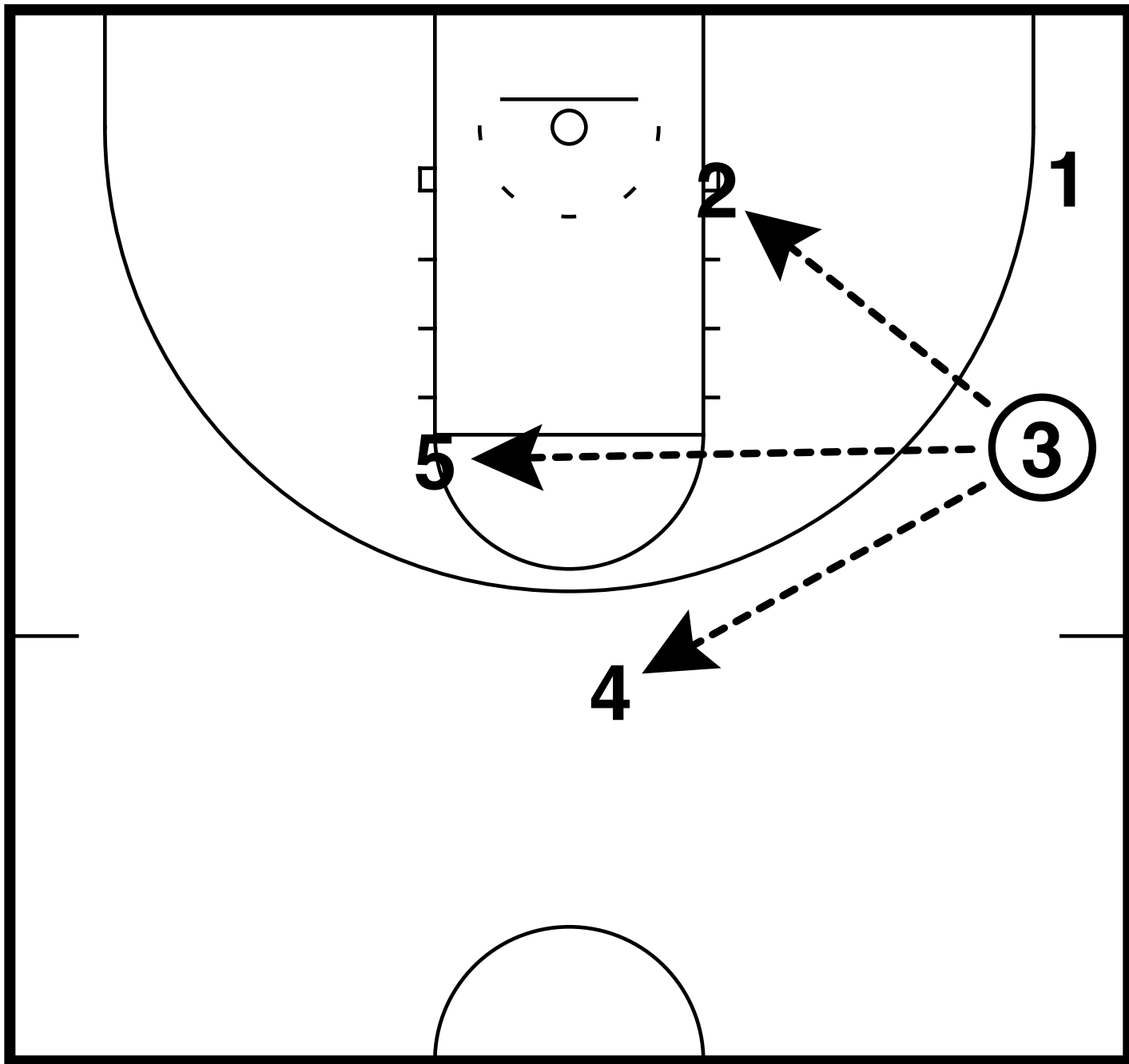
First Cutter (1) sprints right to the rim and then gets out.

### Basic Action Spread



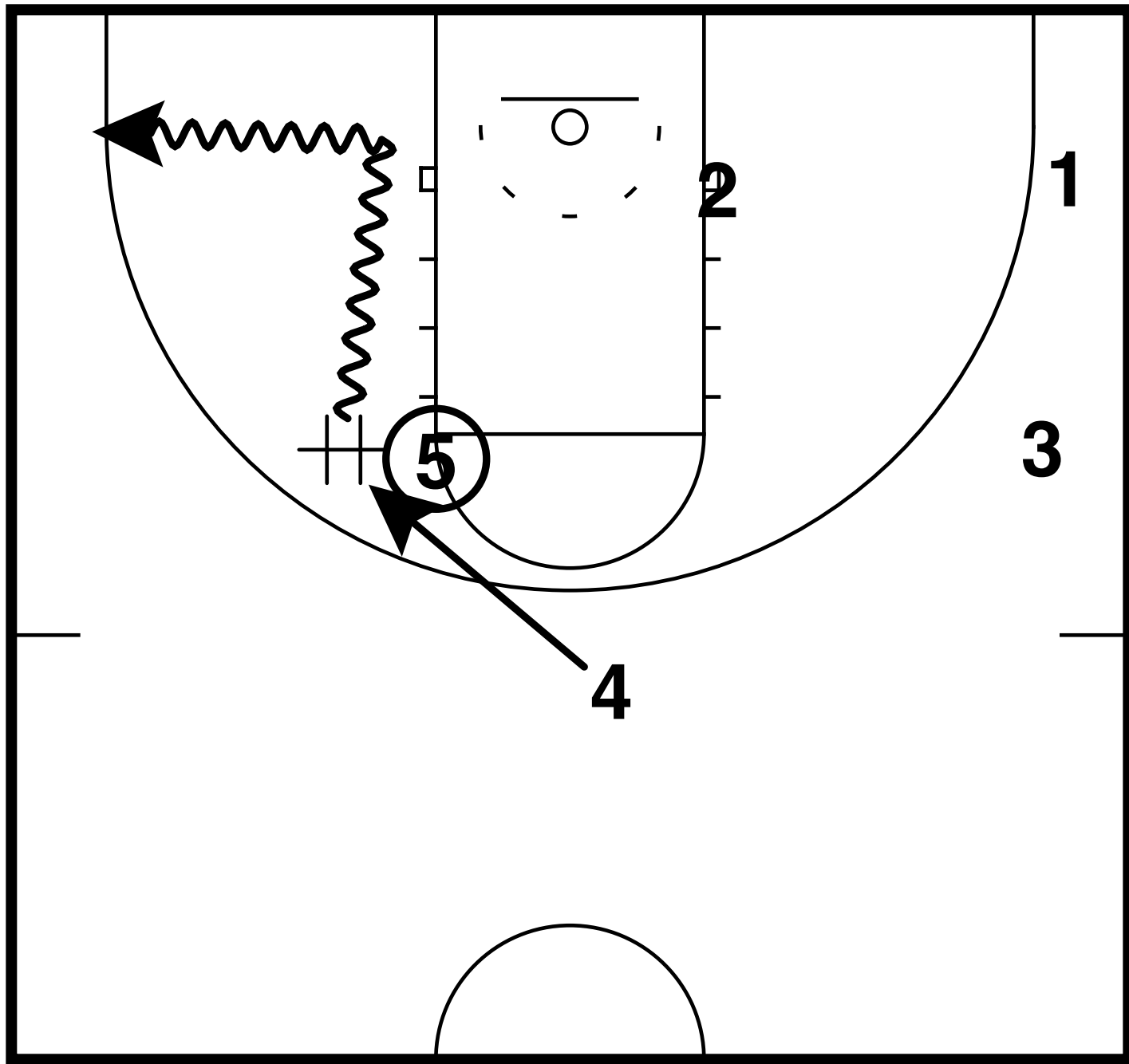
Second Cutter (2) sprints to rim and then posts at the block.

### Basic Action Spread



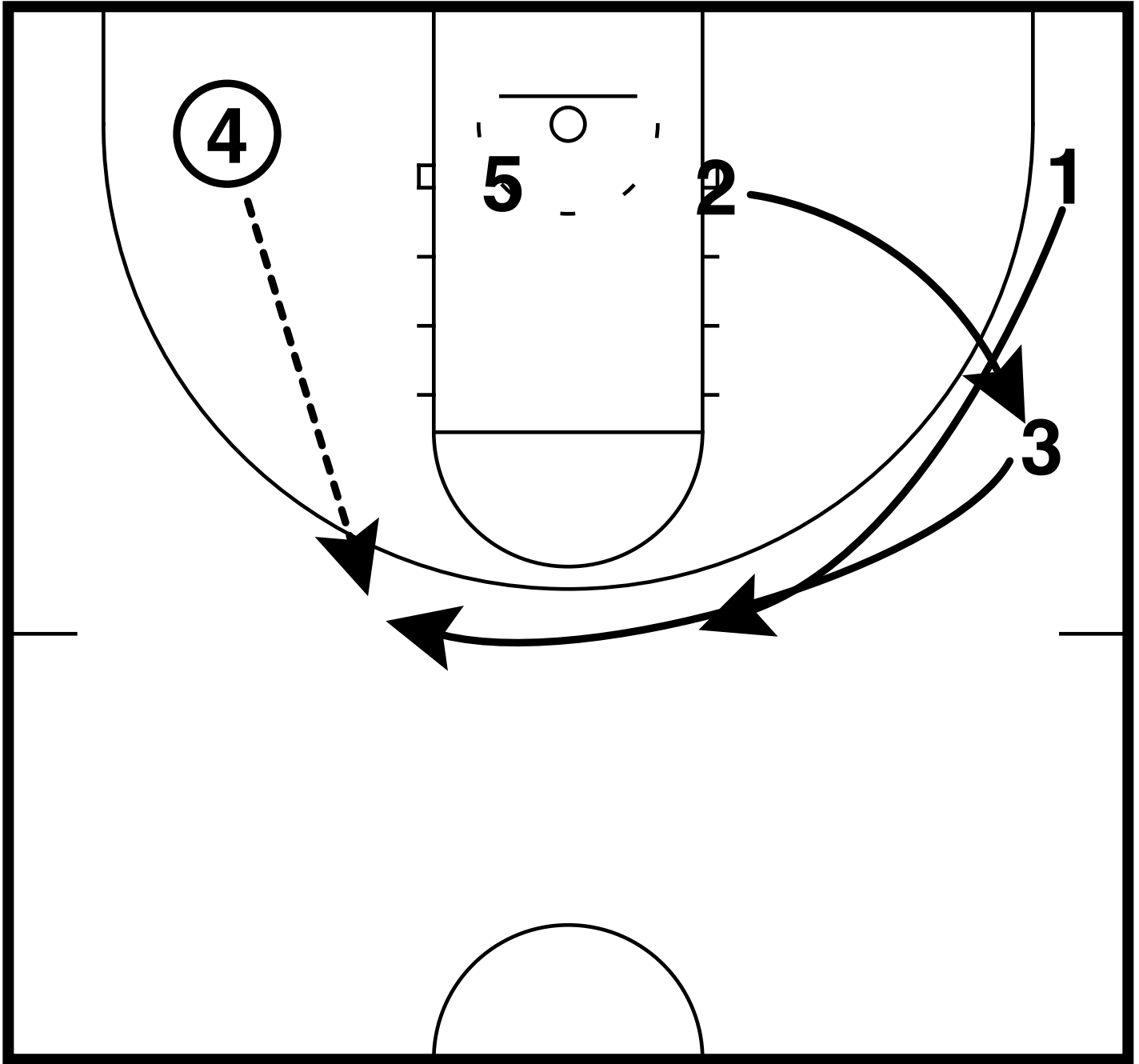
3 has 2 for a post up at the rim or 2 man game between the 4 and the 5. He can either enter directly to the pinch (5) or the top guard (4).

### Basic Action Spread



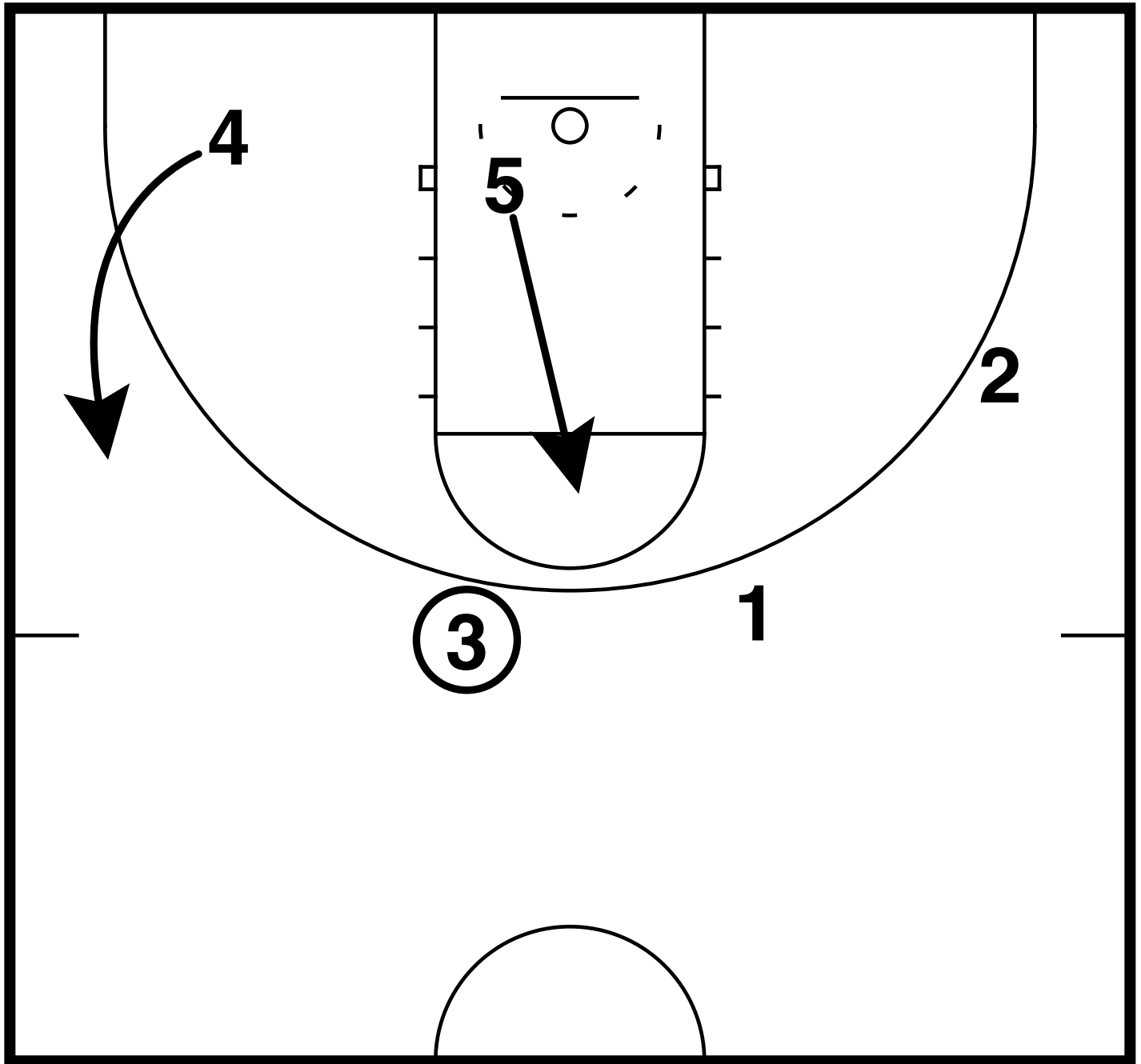
4 sprints off 5 for the dho. 4 gets the ball to the level of the block while 5 rolls.

# Basic Action Spread



3, 2, & 1 all fill  
4 to 3

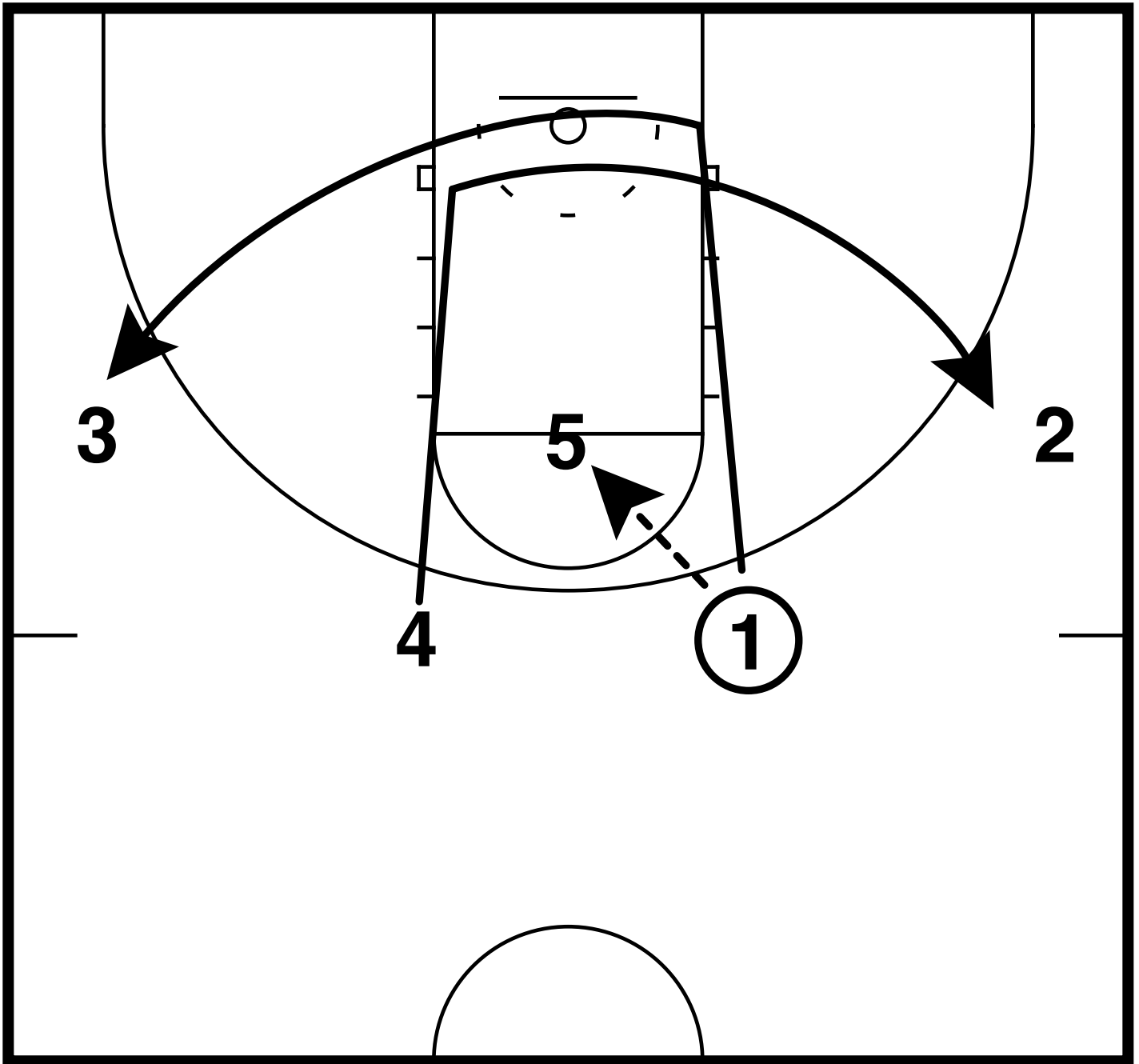
### Basic Action Spread



3 and 5 have a high low opportunity  
If it is not there, 5 will go back to the pinch and 3 can decide which wing he wants to hit, etc.

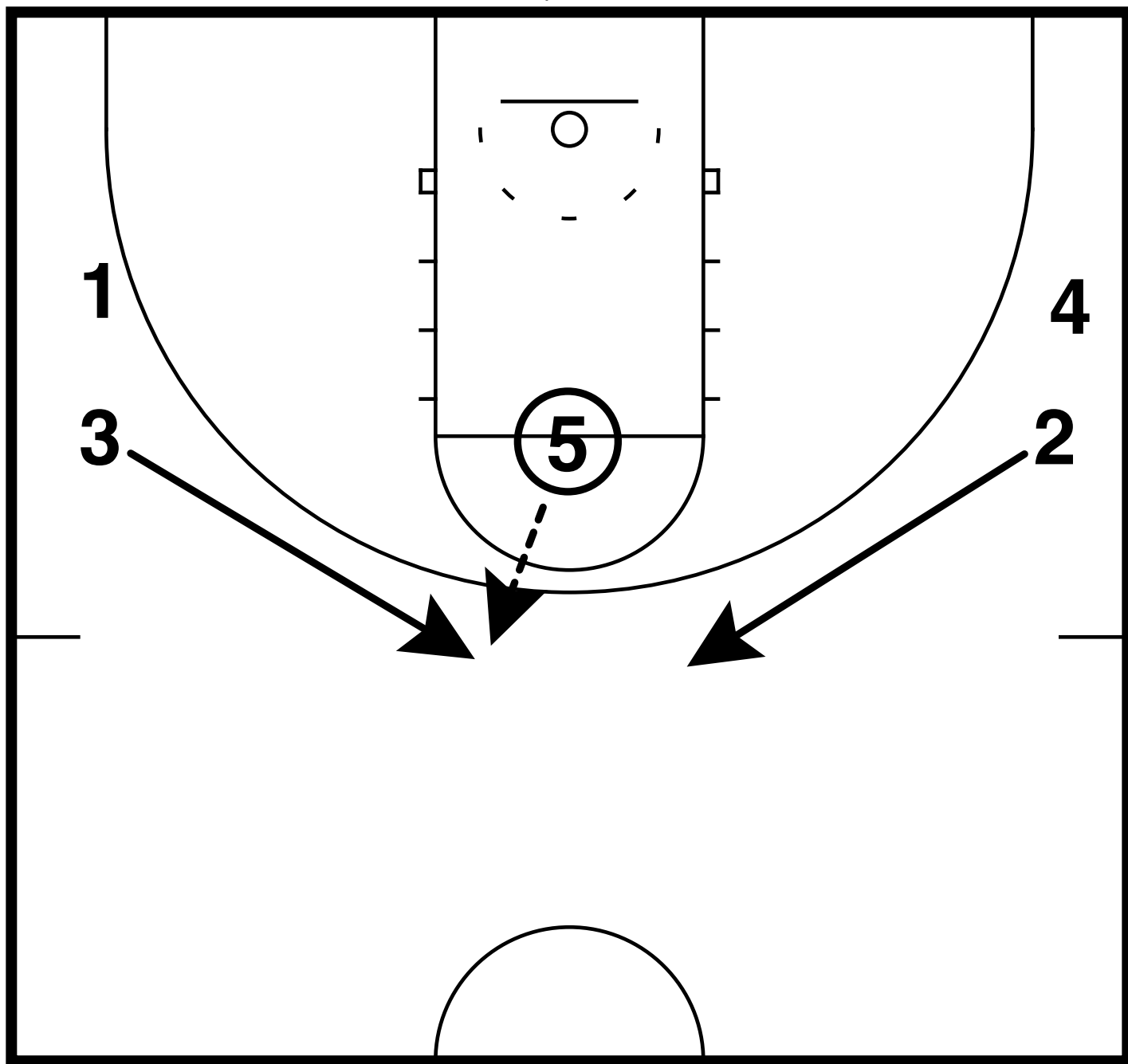


### High Post Entry Spread



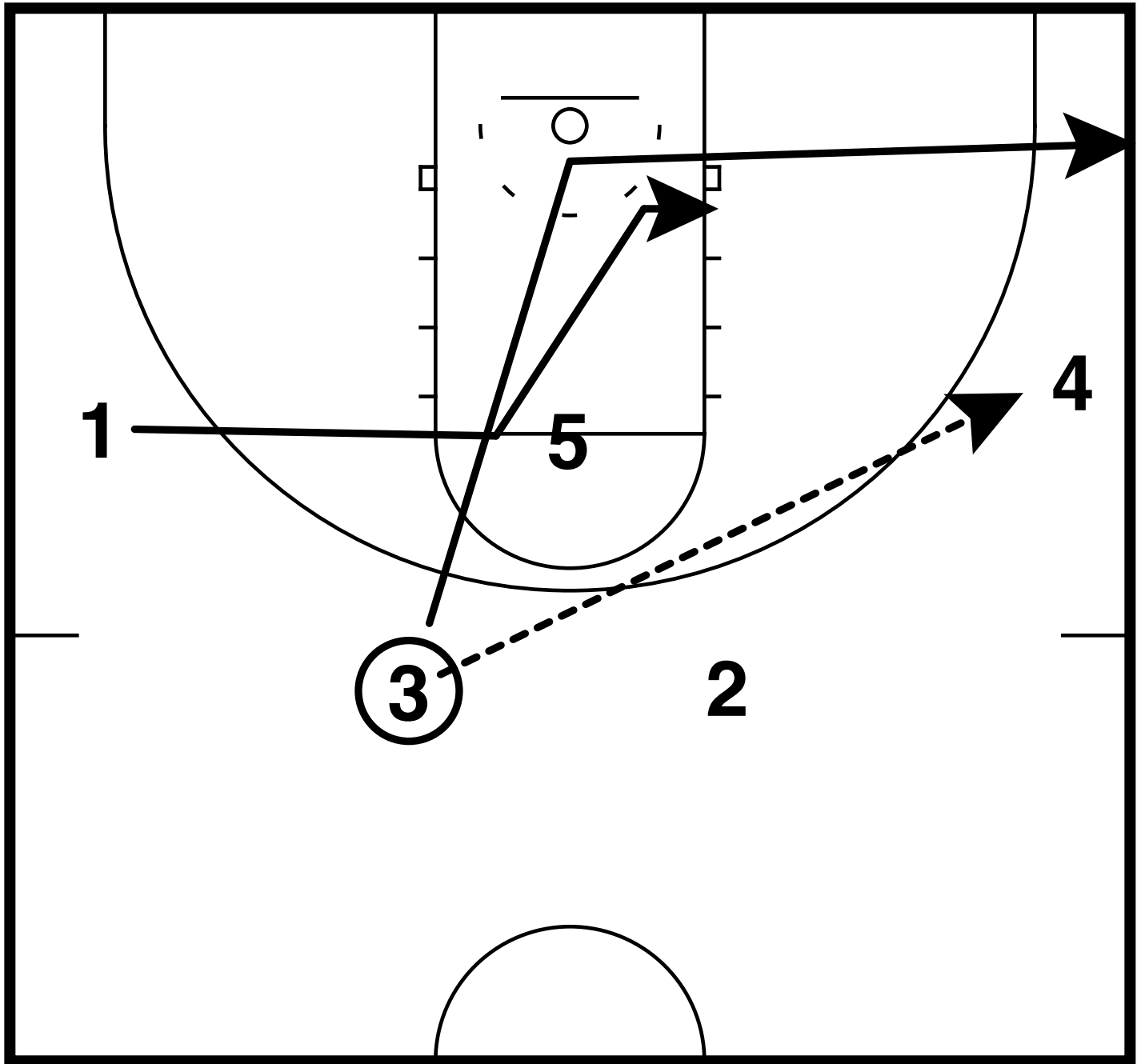
1 to 5  
Whoever enters to the high post will always cut on the low side.

### High Post Entry Spread



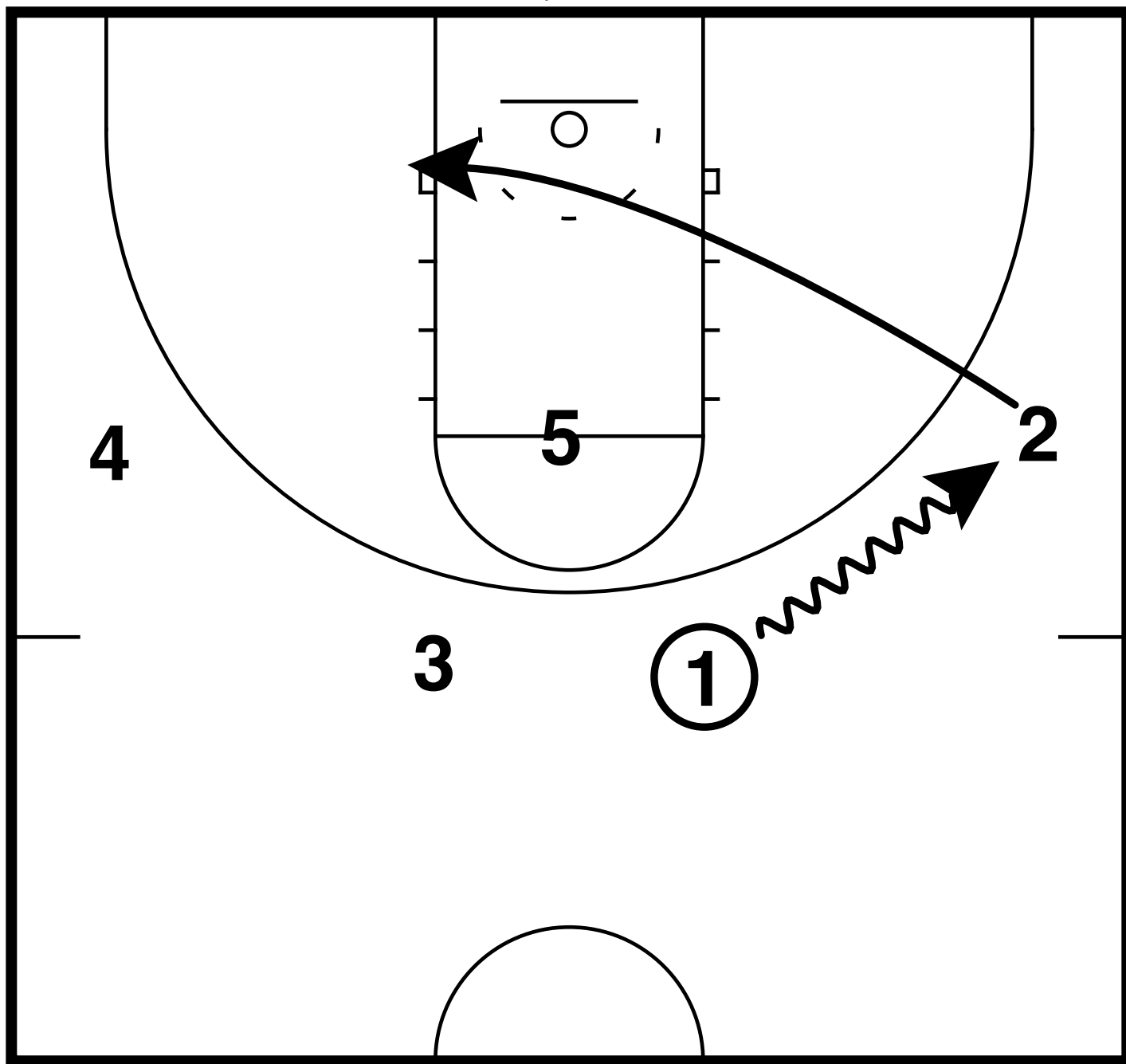
Wings sprint to the top guard spots. 5 hits first open man.

### High Post Entry Spread



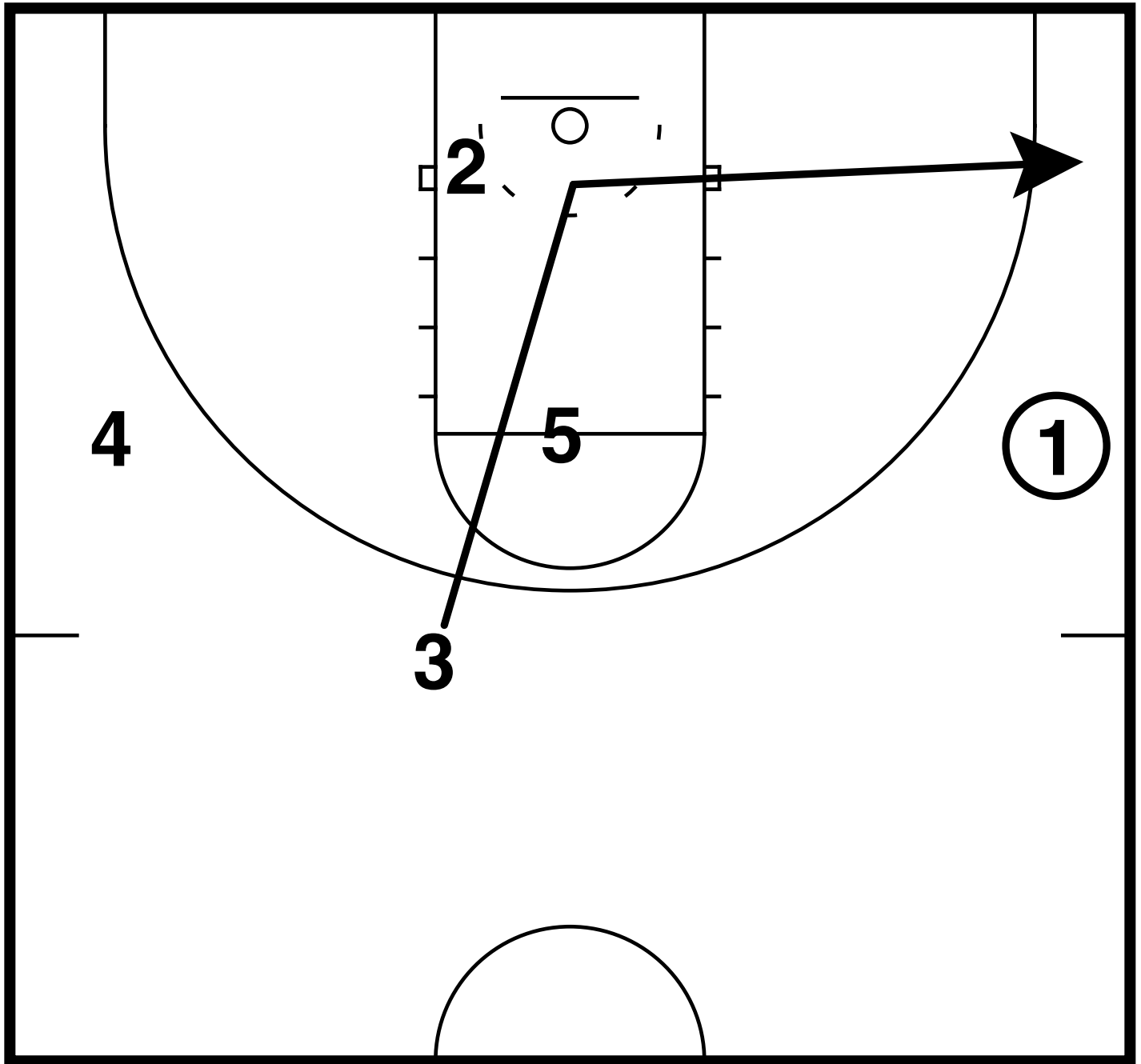
Look for skip right away and sprint into 1st and 2nd cutters. Spread resumes as usual.

### Dribble Entry Spread



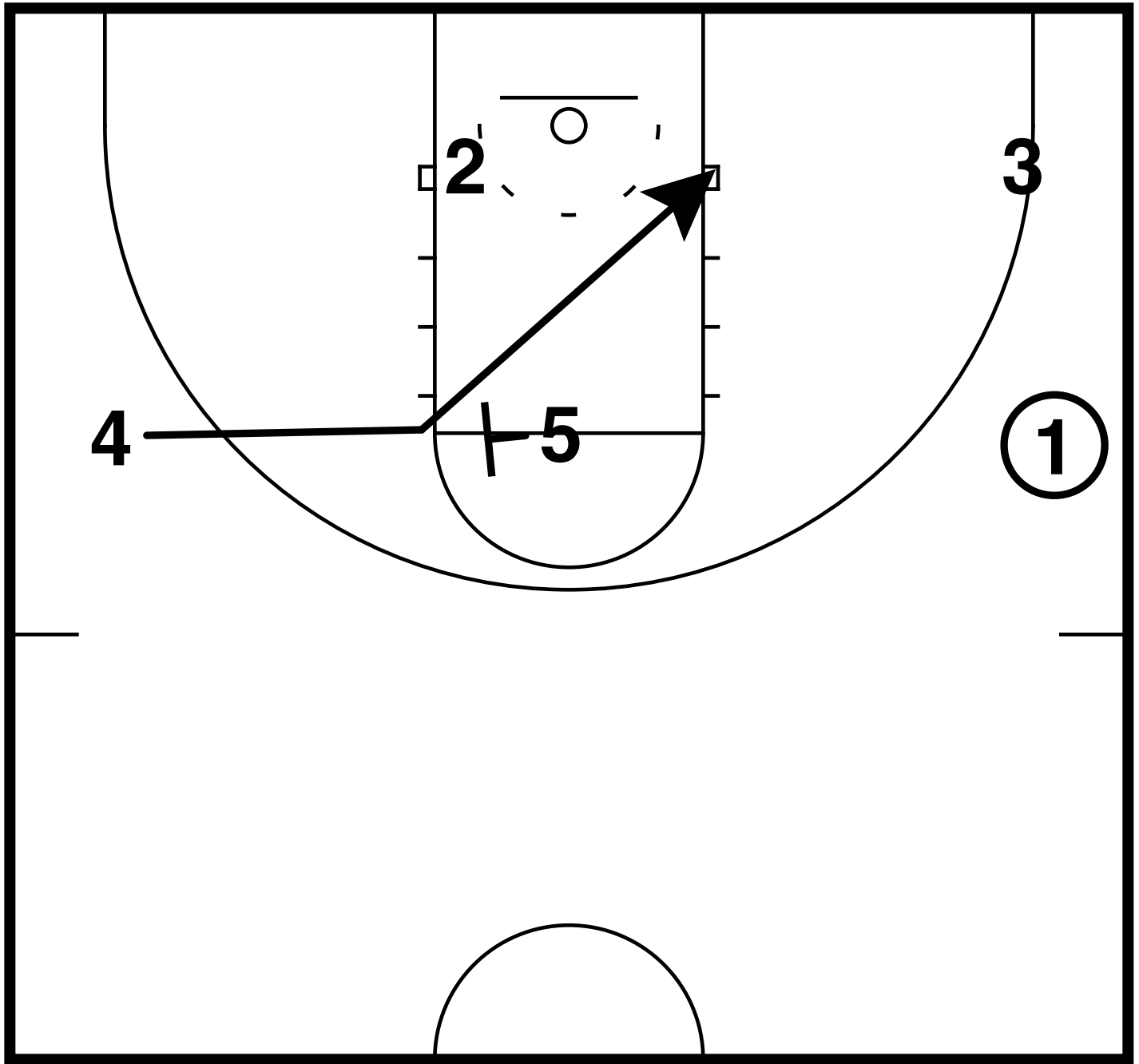
1 dribbles out 2. 2 goes to opposite block.

### Dribble Entry Spread

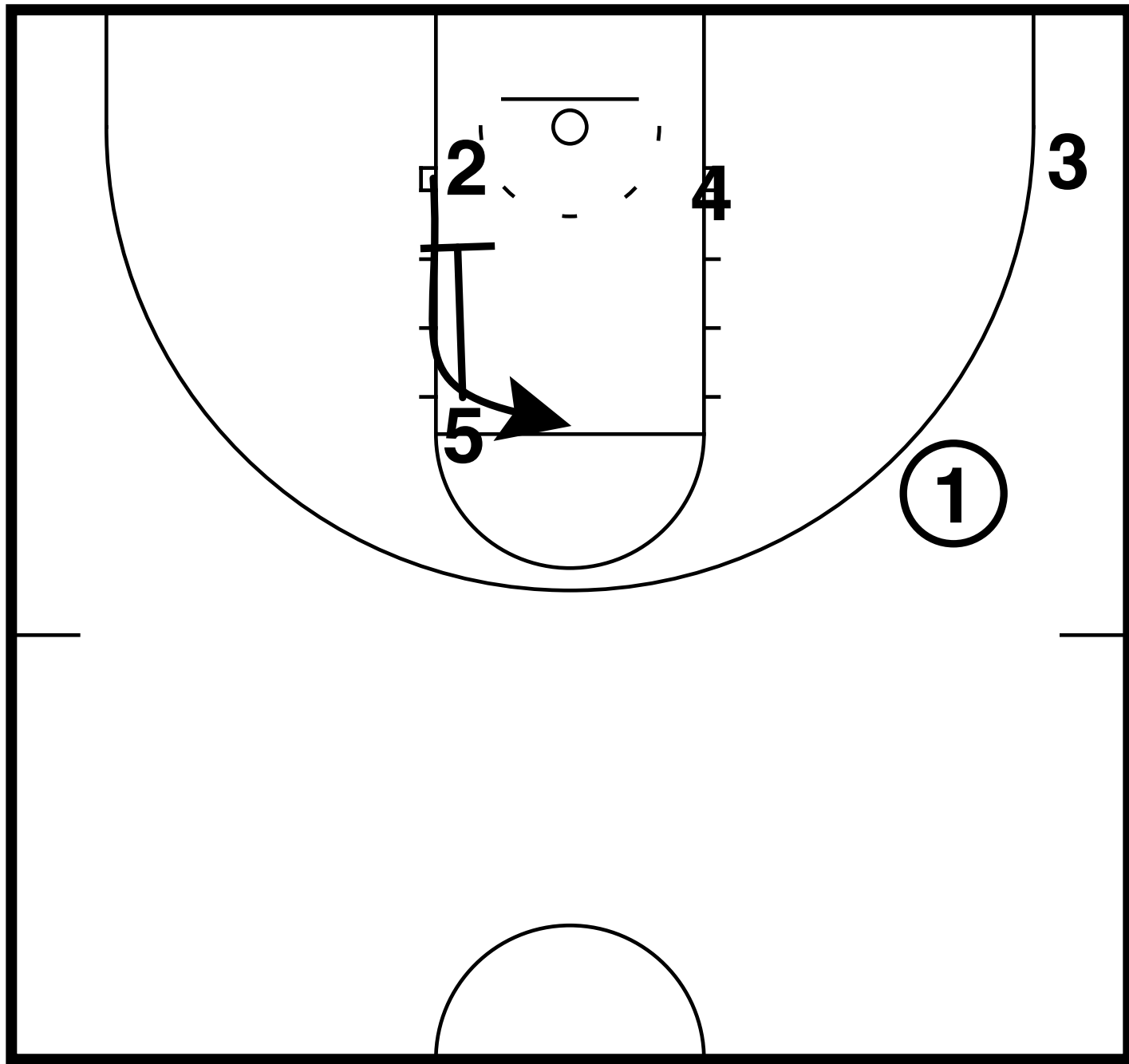


The ball is now on the wing so we have opposite side cutters.

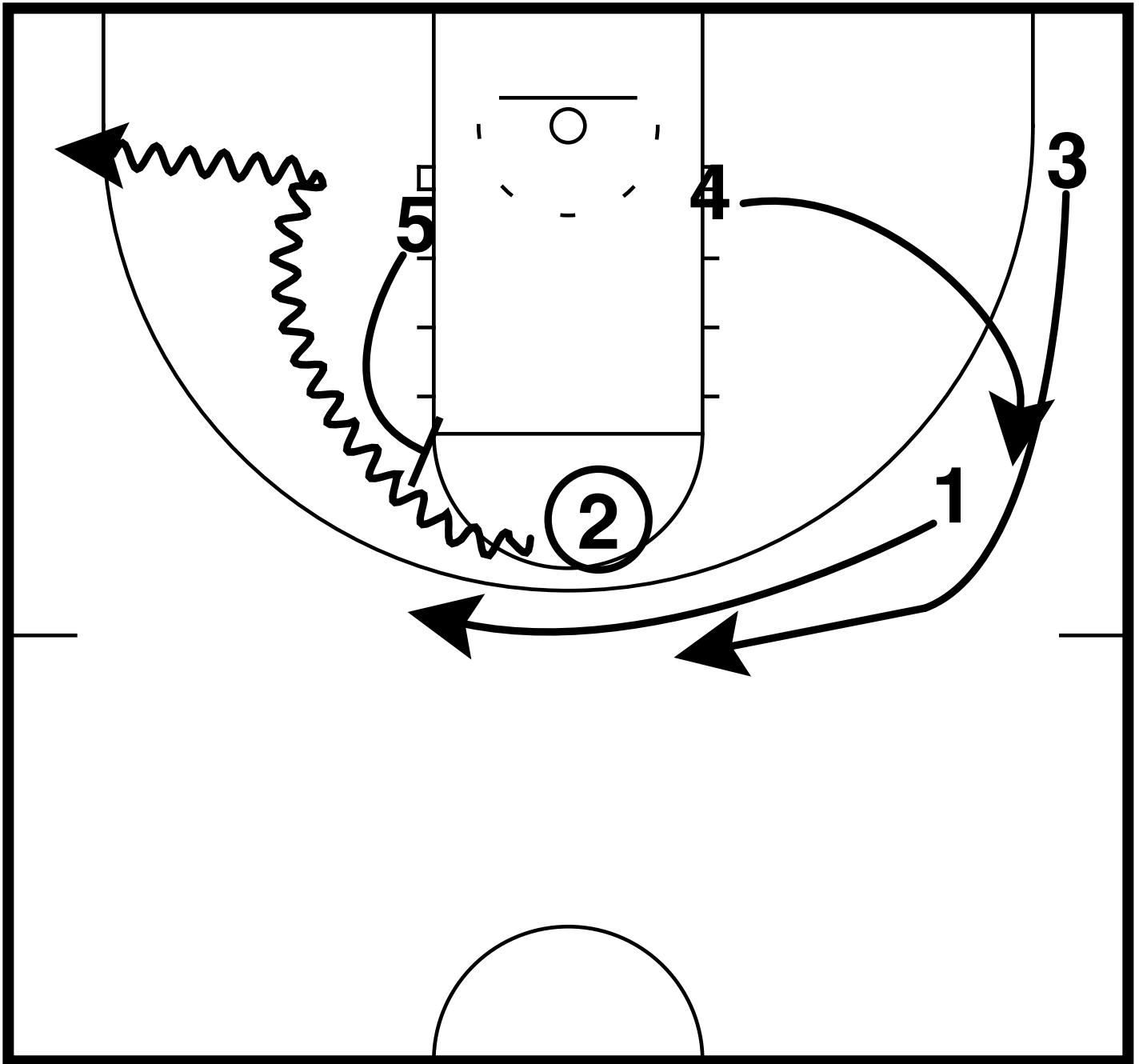


### Dribble Entry Spread
