

DETERMINING PLAYOFF GAME HOSTS 2016 SEASON

Classifications 4A-Div. I, 4A-Div. II, 3A, 2-1A, 8-man Div. I and 8-man Div. II

1. The first round host will always be a district winner and they will always host a district runner-up in classes 4A, 3A, 2-1A, and 8-man.
2. The number of times a school has hosted a playoff round game this year is the first factor considered in determining a host site between two schools BEFORE considering the "East-West" formula.
3. If the "East-West" formula is used to determine which of two schools will host, the formula is as follows this year (an even numbered year):

Farthest east school will serve as host in these rounds/classes:

Regional round	=	8 man Div. I and 3A
Sectional round	=	2-1A
Sub-State round	=	4A DI, 4A DII, 3A and 8-man Div. II

Farthest west school will serve as host in these rounds/classes:

Regional round	=	8 man Div. II
Sectional round	=	4A DI, 4A DII and 3A
Sub-State round	=	2-1A and 8-man DI

Classifications 6A and 5A

1. All playoff games will be hosted by the higher seeded team in each round of the playoffs for classes 6A and 5A.

State Championship Games

1. State Championship Games will use an east/west formula for determining the home team. For 2016, the team on the bottom of the bracket will be considered the home team and will wear dark colored jerseys. The team on the top of the bracket will be considered the visiting team and will wear white jerseys.
