

# KAY LEADERSHIP CAMP CELL PHONE POLICY

The KSHSAA is pleased that you have chosen to give of your time this summer to be a part of this outstanding leadership experience. Because we want all in attendance to reap the rewards of this valuable time together, the following policy will be in-place and strictly enforced.

## **CAMPERS MAY BE IN POSSESSION OF THEIR CELL PHONE WHILE AT KAY LEADERSHIP CAMP UNDER THE FOLLOWING CONDITIONS:**

- **Phones MAY be used from 6:30 a.m. - 10:30 p.m. in the following ways:**
  - **Phones MAY** be used during the day for taking pictures and telling time
  - **Phones MAY** be used during free time for communication (calls, email, texting, etc.)
  - **Phones MAY NOT** be used for communication purposes during "scheduled activities" (meals, general sessions, leadership labs, laugh, love & lift sessions, creative period sessions, recreation, team and mascot meetings, housing meetings)
  - **Phones SHOULD** be set on airplane mode
- **Phones MAY NOT be used from 10:30 p.m. - 6:30 a.m.**

## **CAMPERS WILL BE RESPONSIBLE FOR THEIR PHONE**

- **Campers SHOULD label their phone and charger with their name.**
  - Staff members will not assume responsibility or care for these items.
  - The KSHSAA will not be responsible for lost or stolen phones or chargers.
- **Campers MAY leave their phone in their housing unit during the day, which will be locked to protect camper belongings.**

## **ABUSE OF PHONE PRIVILEGES**

Phones that ring and/or are used for communication purposes during "scheduled activities" and phones that are used after 10:30 p.m. and/or before 6:30 a.m. will be secured by staff, labeled and given to the Camp Director. The Camper will receive their phone back after a conversation with the Camp Director.

## **EMERGENCY PHONE CALLS**

Emergency phone calls can be made to Rock Springs at **(785) 257-3221**. Campers, accompanied by a staff member, will be called out of meetings in the case of an emergency. Otherwise, a number will be taken and the message delivered. Please note that cell phone reception at Rock Springs can be a bit challenging.
