REGISTRATION FEES

The KSHSAA establishes registration fees in accordance with costs of purchasing, printing and distributing materials used by our officials. Dues for NFOA membership are included as part of the registration fee. The registration fee for one sport is **\$55** and **\$25** for each additional sport. If track and field is the only sport you register in the fee is **\$35**.

For officials registered 21 years or more, the registration fee is \$55 for the first sport and \$10 for any additional sport provided you register by July 14.

The KSHSAA will accept registrations for a sport through the registration deadline date listed on the schedule enclosed in this mailing. A **NEW** official's registration for football, basketball, volleyball, wrestling, soccer, baseball, softball and track & field is **VOIDED** if the official fails to complete the required online rules meeting or in-person officials rules meeting for each sport in which you are registered. Only registered officials may be assigned games via Arbiter.

A portion of your KSHSAA registration fee pays your membership in the NFOA. Kansas is a 100% NFOA membership state which means your membership includes access to the NFHS Central Hub through the ArbiterSports website. This section contains officiating educational content exclusively for high school officials including a searchable rules database, publications, video and more. Your membership also includes NFOA insurance, publications and other benefits. To complete the NFOA membership and provide you with NFOA insurance coverage, an official is requested to provide only the last four digits of your social security number with your KSHSAA registration.

LATE FEES

If you were registered in 2018-2019 for Football, Volleyball, Basketball, Wrestling and/or Soccer (boys and girls), you must register for the 2019-2020 year by July 14 OR pay an additional \$20 late fee. Baseball, Softball, Girls Soccer and Track & Field officials must register by January 14 OR pay an additional \$20 late fee.

OFFICIALS RULES MEETINGS

In a continuing effort to provide quality training opportunities for our registered officials, the KSHSAA is conducting a series of in-person officials rules meetings for each sport, every other year. These meetings are mandatory. In the year an officials meeting is offered for a specific sport, there WILL NOT be an online rules meeting option available in that activity. **You must attend the in-person officials meeting to receive rules meeting credit.** The following sports require attendance at an in-person officials rules meeting during the 2019-20 school year:

KSHSAA registered officials CANNOT receive rules meeting credit by attending an out of state meeting or receive credit for an out of state exam.

In emergency situations, officials missing the required in person meeting must contact the sport administration within 5 days of the missed meeting.

ARBITER INFORMATION

Only KSHSAA registered officials will be available for assignment through Arbiter. **THEREFORE IT IS IMPERATIVE THAT YOU REGISTER EARLY WITH THE KSHSAA IN ORDER TO BE AVAILABLE FOR ASSIGNMENT BY COMMISSIONERS/LEAGUES AND SCHOOLS USING ARBITER.** Please see the enclosed instructions for the Arbiter assigning system.

ONLINE OFFICIALS LICENSE

The KSHSAA does not mail licenses. Officials can obtain a printable version of their KSHSAA license, NFOA membership card, and NFHS Sportsmanship pocket card on your official's page of the KSHSAA website.

OFFICIALS DIRECTORY

The OFFICIALS DIRECTORY will be printed this summer listing all officials who have registered by **July 14**. This publication will be mailed to member schools. The online directory will always have the current list of registered officials.

RECOGNITION AWARDS

We want to recognize you for your service! Officials with 20 or more years of service as a KSHSAA registered official should login at www.kshsaa.org and complete an Official's Service Award application. Officials can apply for 20, 30, 40 and 50 year awards. The application should be printed, filled out and sent in to our office **at least 30 days prior to the state event at which you elect to receive your plaque.** Awards are presented only at KSHSAA state championship events, or can be shipped to your home address.

NON-COMPLIANCE PENALTY FEE POLICY

By action of the Executive Board, officials who fail to comply with the rules meeting attendance and/or examination regulations for two consecutive years may register only after payment of a \$75.00 penalty fee.

PUBLICATIONS

Rules books, examinations and other materials will be sent to you prior to each sport season. This material will arrive in plenty of time for you to complete the open book exam prior to the deadline date, provided you register early.

*** Officials may still register after the online cutoff date at in-person officials rules meetings (see schedule of meetings included in this packet).**

The KSHSAA rules testing process for head high school coaches, head middle/junior high school coaches and officials will continue to be administered online only. Officials are required to complete the online exam within the date range for their respective sport(s).

For sports requiring an in-person officials rules meeting there is **NO** online rules meeting option. **YOU MUST ATTEND THE IN-PERSON OFFICIALS RULES MEETING TO RECEIVE RULES MEETING CREDIT.** The Officials Rules Meeting Schedule is included in this packet. In 2019-2020, the KSHSAA will also be offering a limited number of in-person rules meetings at select locations across Kansas in the sports of Football, Soccer and Baseball. **Officials registered in Football, Soccer and/or Baseball may choose to fulfill their rules meeting requirement online OR at one of the in-person rules meetings listed on the schedule.** The dates the online rules meetings are available to receive credit are listed above.

Detailed instructions for attending the online rules meetings and completing the online examinations will be sent to you with your rules books and other sport specific information prior to the first rules meeting date for that specific sport.

ARBITERSPORTS INFORMATION FOR KSHSAA REGISTERED OFFICIALS

The majority of leagues use ArbiterSports to notify officials of game assignments. The KSHSAA pays for all school league commissioners to use this assigning tool. The KSHSAA will use ArbiterSports to notify all officials of postseason assignments. **The KSHSAA DOES NOT assign officials for regular season contests.**

Only KSHSAA registered officials will be available for assignment through Arbiter. **THEREFORE IT IS IMPERATIVE THAT YOU REGISTER EARLY WITH THE KSHSAA IN ORDER TO BE AVAILABLE FOR ASSIGNMENT BY COMMISSIONERS/LEAGUES AND SCHOOLS USING ARBITER.**

Please note the following regarding the ArbiterSports officials assigning system:

1. All officials registered with the KSHSAA will be automatically placed in the KSHSAA Administration Arbiter account #103765.
 - You must join this account in order to be assigned games by individual schools.
 - You must join this account in order to be added to sub-groups (commissioner) accounts.
2. **YOU MUST PROVIDE AN EMAIL ADDRESS WHEN YOU REGISTER WITH THE KSHSAA. After registering with the KSHSAA, login to your ArbiterSports account and check the email address listed. Be sure it is the email address you want to use to receive game assignments through ArbiterSports. You must have an email address in ArbiterSports to receive game assignments.**
3. Officials registering for the first time will be sent a welcome message via email to join the KSHSAA Administration account. Officials must accept this group invitation in order to be added to other groups.
4. Officials that were registered for the 2018-2019 school year will remain in Arbiter sports as assignable until the new registration period begins for 2019-2020.
5. Once you accept the invitation to be in group #103765 (KSHSAA Administration) other commissioners can choose to add you as an official to their account.
6. You will receive a welcome invitation from each sub-group (commissioner) that wishes to add you to their account. You will need to accept each sub-group invitation in order to be assigned by that commissioner.
7. In order to remain in the KSHSAA Administration account and be assignable an official **MUST** register with the KSHSAA prior to the last date for registration in that sport (see other information in this mailing).
8. If an official fails to register with the KSHSAA by the registration deadline the official will show as unregistered in ArbiterSports and will not be able to receive game assignments. **ANY EXISTING ASSIGNMENTS AT THIS TIME WILL BE REMOVED.**
9. In order to not jeopardize your ability to receive games from individual schools or from league commissioners, officials should register with the KSHSAA as quickly as possible after June 1.
10. Information on blocking dates, accepting/declining games and other functions of ArbiterSports is available on the ArbiterSports website.
11. It is each official's responsibility to keep up to date all contact information (including your email address) in the KSHSAA.org website account and all Arbiter accounts.
12. **NFHS Central Hub** – Because you are a registered official in Kansas and Kansas is a 100% NFOA membership state with the NFHS, you have access to a wealth of educational and training information through NFHS Central Hub on the ArbiterSports website. This service is FREE to all registered KSHSAA officials. Please take advantage of part of your registration fee and check out the Central Hub! Features include: searchable rules books and case books, video clips of plays, animated simulations of mechanics and the Officials Quarterly.
