A hospitality room with food and beverage available for purchase, will be available in Southwest Heritage Hall for **school administrators, officials, coaches and media only**. Tickets (K-12 \$9, Adults \$11) for each day will be available at the box office located outside on the north and south arena plazas or online at www.tonyspizzaeventscenter.com.

In order to help make this tournament a smooth and successful event, please spend some time reviewing the information in your 2018-2019 KSHSAA Wrestling Manual. Some important points to pass on to your staff and student body are:

- Banners and signs are to be attached **only** to the arena railing system and must not exceed 4ft. x 12ft. Please use rope or twine to attach banners, tape is prohibited. (*See your manual*)
- Helium balloons and confetti are **NOT ALLOWED** in the arena. The decision to restrict any item into the arena is that of the Safety/Security staff and is done so with patrons' best interest in mind. Any item(s) in question should be brought to the Administrative Offices prior to the patron entering the arena.
- Reminder: cheerleaders are to remain no closer than 10ft from the mats while the matches are in progress. Additionally, please inform them not to climb more than one high.
- Pep squad, cheerleaders, and school administrators are to see that students do not stand on chairs. Schools will be held responsible for any damage to chairs or other property.
- Pass gate policy: Review Section V of your manual, regarding complimentary tickets and pass gate procedures (Also see pass gate Form #BB9 for Girls and #BB10 for Boys). The pass gate

for school administrators and cheerleaders will be located at the north arena entrance. Players and coaches will enter through the west arena door (see map).


- Ticket takers will stamp ticket holder's hand for exit and re-entry to the arena.

The hospitality room is for school administrators, coaches, game officials, tournament volunteers and select facility personnel **ONLY**, media, team members or family members of administrators or coaches are allowed.

- Please refer to the policy on artificial noisemakers. (*See your manual.*)
- Remind students and athletes that the Tony's Pizza Events Center is not responsible for valuables at the tournament and please suggest that they not be brought.
- **NO FOOD OR BEVERAGE MAY BE BROUGHT INTO THE TONY'S PIZZA EVENTS CENTER.**
Please see Tony's Pizza Events Center Food policy included in this packet for more information.
- Weigh-in and start times are found on in your manual.
- Post event policy: In the medal rounds, spectators are only allowed on the east end of the floor to take pictures at the podium, in between matches.
- All items brought into the arena are subject to inspection. Please inform fans, spectators and teams to arrive early as delays entering the arena could be possible. Items included, but not limited to, are purses, cameras, camera bags, backpacks, coats, instrument cases and equipment bags, etc. are subject to inspection.
- If your school will be arranging student spectators to arrive on buses please call ahead so we can make ticketing arrangements in advance.

I thank you in advance for your cooperation. Good luck in the tournament and we look forward to another successful KSHSAA Wrestling Tournament!

FOOD GUIDELINES

Outside food and beverage is not permitted into the Tony's Pizza Events Center. Any items in question should be brought to the Administrative Offices prior to the patron entering the arena.

Teams Participating in 2019 Wrestling Tournament: No outside food or beverage will be allowed inside of the Tony's Pizza Events Center with exception for event participants (players & coaches) to have one plastic bottle beverage (water or sports drink with preference to Pepsi products) and a single small nutritional snack (ex: fruit, protein bar) for consumption in event participant areas only such as locker room, back stage area or team bench. If the team has a cooler, the coach or team host may check it through the back door near the lockers. A security guard will check the cooler and allow it to be taken directly to northwest Heritage Hall. **The team cooler can NOT come through the front doors.**

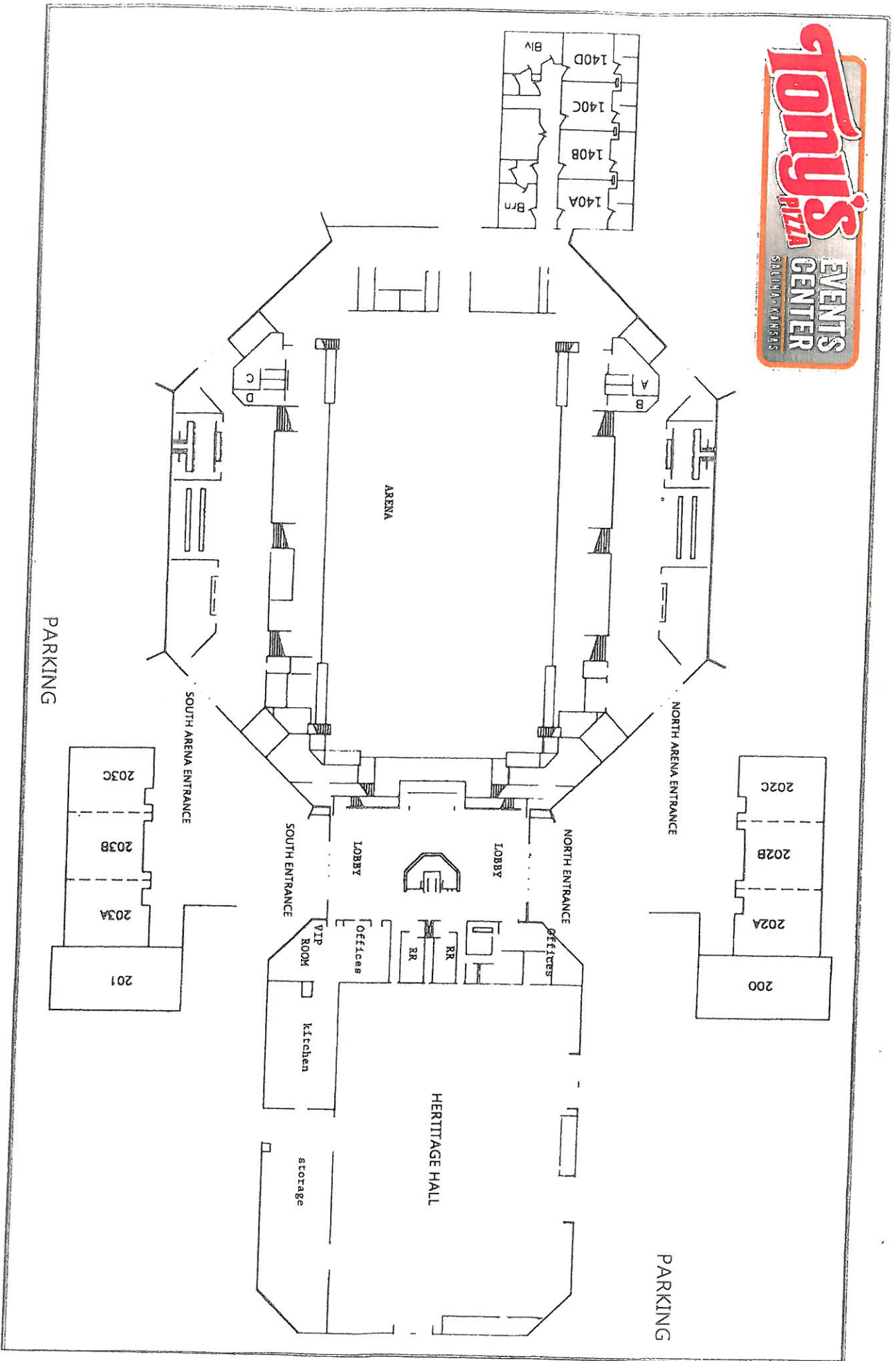
Officials
