ADMINISTRATIVE REPORTS

The Executive Board heard reports from the Executive Director and the administrative staff regarding the status of programs and services of the Association. The staff reported on the culmination of winter activities and plans for the upcoming spring activity season. The Executive Director gave a financial report.

LIABILITY AND CATASTROPHIC INSURANCE UPDATE

Scot Buxton, Bob Coughlin and Jan Mason of Willis Towers Watson, met with the Executive Board to provide an update on information pertaining to liability, catastrophic and medical coverage for member schools of the KSHSAA for the 2017-18 school year. It was voted unanimously to purchase coverage through Mutual of Omaha. Information regarding coverage and the premium per student will be mailed to all member school superintendents and principals in May with the membership mailing. There are no changes in coverage from recent years. Specific information regarding coverage and benefits for the 2017-18 school year will be provided in the mailing. The premium per student will increase by 33 cents (5.5%) next school year. Member schools will pay \$6.39 to cover each participating student in KSHSAA activities, regardless of the number of activities in which the student participates.

POSTSEASON OFFICIATING FEES

Based on the established three-year rotation, staff presented Executive Board members with historic background on fees presently paid to officials working postseason contests in soccer, swimming & diving, track & field and area supervisors. CLASSICAL SCHOOL OF WICHITA

Director of Operations Josh Dyson and Athletic Director Tim Dolloff from the Classical School of Wichita met with the Executive Board to discuss the possibility of transitioning the school from KSHSAA Approved School status to full membership. The school has been an Approved School for ten years and is in the process of seeking accreditation from the Association of Classical and Christian Schools which is based in Moscow, Idaho. During this initial meeting, the school provided the Board members with general information about their school, its history, philosophy of instruction and its current athletic/activity programs and schedules. In addition they discussed their ability to comply with KSHSAA rules on qualification of coaches, student financial aid policy and procedures and other Handbook rules. Mr. Dyson explained the school is in the process of preparing for an accreditation team visit by ACCS next fall. No action was taken and the school was directed to continue to keep Mr. Musselman informed of their progress regarding accreditation.

APPROVED SCHOOL APPLICATION FEE INCREASED FOR 2017-2018

The Executive Board voted unanimously to increase the application fee for Approved School status to \$200 effective with the 2017-18 school year. Approved school renewal applications are mailed in May each year to coincide with the mailing of membership renewal materials for member schools.

KANSAS CONCEALED CARRY – EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2017

Mr. Musselman updated the Board on recent communications sent by KSHSAA legal counsel to the legal counsel of seven public universities in Kansas who host KSHSAA state championship games and tournaments, relevant to the July 1, 2017 effective date for changes in state law governing concealed carry weapons. Changes in the law have potential ramifications for security procedures in arenas and stadiums the KSHSAA utilizes for state competitions.

FOOTBALL OFFICIALS UNIFORM CHANGE APPROVED

Assistant Executive Director Mark Lentz proposed a change in the KSHSAA Officials Handbook language governing the football officials' uniform. Following discussion, it was voted to add the following language addressing officials' football uniforms:

“Football

A black-and-white vertically striped, long or short-sleeved knit shirt shall be worn. The shirts shall have either 1 inch or a maximum of 2 ¼ inch strips, a black knit cuff and Byron Collar. All officials, in a given game, are to wear the same type shirt. Standard, all-white tapered knickers may be worn with a short overlap below the knee (not more than 4 inches). In addition, black official pants with a 1 ¼ inch white stripe down each leg may be worn in place of the traditional knickers. The only pant allowed to be worn is the style made specifically for football officiating. All crew members MUST be dressed in the same uniform. There are no exceptions at any level. One-piece stockings with a modified northwestern stripe (1/2 inch white, ½ inch black, 1 inch white, ½ inch black, ½ inch white) are required. The width of the black showing below the knickers should be the same as the wide black band below the striping pattern. Black football shoes with black laces are required. Shoes should be shined before each game. Black baseball-style cap with white piping is required. For the purpose of identification, the referee shall wear a solid, white baseball-style cap. A black leather belt 1 ¼ inch to 2 inches wide with a plain buckle. The uniforms should fit properly and be clean and neat.”

PROPOSAL APPROVED FOR VIRTUAL KSHSAA HALL OF FAME AND RECORDS CENTER

The Executive Board gave unanimous approval for the staff to move forward with a project to develop a virtual KSHSAA Hall of Fame which will allow access to the history and photographs of all KSHSAA Hall of Fame inductees and their biographical information. In addition, the project will be developed with the capacity to include other KSHSAA awards such as the Governor's Award winners, Kopelk Memorial photos of state champion teams and individuals and in time will incorporate statistical records maintained by the KSHSAA.
