### ADMINISTRATIVE REPORTS

The Executive Board heard reports from the Executive Director and the administrative staff regarding the status of programs and services of the Association. The staff reported on the culmination of winter activities and plans for the upcoming spring activity season. The Executive Director gave a financial report.

### LIABILITY AND CATASTROPHIC INSURANCE UPDATE

Scot Buxton, John Puetz and Jan Mason of Willis Towers Watson Insurance, met with the Executive Board to provide an update on information pertaining to liability, catastrophic and medical coverage for member schools of the KSHSAA for the 2018-19 school year. It was voted unanimously to purchase coverage through Mutual of Omaha. Information regarding coverage and the premium per student will be mailed to all member school superintendents and principals in May with the annual membership mailing. There are no changes in coverage from last year. Specific information regarding coverage and benefits for the 2018-19 school year will be provided in the membership mailing. The premium per student will increase by 22 cents (3.4%) next school year. Member schools will pay **\$6.61 to cover each student (grades 7 – 12) participating in KSHSAA activities**, regardless of the number of activities in which the student participates.

### POSTSEASON OFFICIATING FEES

Based on the established three-year rotation, staff presented Executive Board members with historic background on fees presently paid to officials working postseason contests in football, basketball, gymnastics and cross country. ## 2019 SUMMER MORATORIUM PROPOSAL ADVANCES TO BOARD OF DIRECTORS

Given the widespread interest and support voiced at the October KSHSAA regional meetings, the Executive Board and staff have been developing a proposal creating a summer moratorium rule. At their January meeting, staff presented the Executive Board with an initial draft designed to create a period of seven (7) consecutive days where contact between school employed coaches and coach aides, and athletes would be prohibited, and member school facilities would be closed to student athletes in grades 7-12 for participation in school sponsored athletic activities. School cheerleading teams and music groups would be exempt in the same manner as they currently are during the Buffer Week.

At the January meeting, the Board asked for a summer rule similar in its application and interpretation to the existing Christmas Moratorium and Buffer Week rules. Following discussion, the proposed addition to **Rule 9, Section 1, Article 5**, was unanimously approved by the Executive Board for placement on the agenda of the Board of Directors for final action at their next meeting on April 27, 2018. The Executive Board chose the summer of 2019 as the effective date in recognition of the fact that many 2018 summer events are already scheduled.

**\*Note: If approved by the Board of Directors, the summer moratorium rule would become effective beginning in the summer of 2019 with the moratorium dates of: Monday, July 1 – Sunday, July 7 inclusive.**

### Rule 9 FALL AND CHRISTMAS ATHLETIC MORATORIUMS

#### Section 1: General Regulations (apply to grades 7-12)

#### CHRISTMAS HOLIDAY PRACTICE/ACTIVITIES WINTER MORATORIUM

**Art. 1:** The Executive Board shall establish a consecutive five-day period (including December 25) where there shall be no school practice or interscholastic contests or activities.

- There shall be no interschool activities.
- There shall be no staff members present for any interscholastic activities.
- There shall be no staff members present for any interscholastic activity practice in activities under the jurisdiction of the KSHSAA.

**Art. 2:** There shall be no group interscholastic activity practice either on or outside school premises under supervision of school employees.

**Art. 3:** Music groups may perform, provided there is no practice in the school facilities and their performance is locally and on a volunteer basis only.

**Art. 4:** Trips by school activity students or groups are permissible, provided the students do not participate physically in any activity related to interschool activities.



## SUMMER MORATORIUM WEEK

Art. 5: The Executive Board shall establish a consecutive seven day period (including July 4) where there shall be no school related athletic activities. During this time, coaches (licensed teacher coaches and coach aides employed by member schools) shall be prohibited from engaging in any type of activity involving student athletes whether it be practice, training, weight lifting, conditioning, competition or travel.

All member school athletic facilities will be closed during this period to school personnel and students grades 7-12. If member school athletic facilities also serve as non-school community recreation facilities, these facilities may remain open during the moratorium so long as no school teams are playing and no school coaches are coaching the teams/individuals. During this one week dead period, students may attend camps or competitions but may not do so with their school coaches.

This moratorium does not impact fine arts or spirit activities.

## **CLASSICAL SCHOOL OF WICHITA APPROVED FOR MEMBERSHIP STATUS IN 2018-19**

Principal Wade Ortego, Director of Operations Josh Dyson and Athletic Director Tim Dolloff from the Classical School of Wichita met with the Executive Board to discuss the possibility of transitioning the school from KSHSAA Approved School status to full membership. The school has been an Approved School for 11 years and has now secured accreditation from the Association of Classical and Christian Schools. After an initial meeting one year ago, school representatives again met with the Executive Board and provided detailed information about their school, its history, enrollment, demographics, philosophy of instruction, financial aid policies and procedures, facilities and the school's history in administering its athletic and activity programs. The presentation also addressed the school's ability to comply with KSHSAA rules and policies regarding qualification of coaches and other Handbook requirements. Upon conclusion of the presentation and question and answer period, the Executive Board voted to approve the Classical School of Wichita for membership status effective with the 2018-19 school year.

## **MEMBER SCHOOL DUES APPROVED FOR 2018-2019**

The Executive Board voted unanimously to continue member school dues at the current level of \$400 senior high and \$125 middle school/junior high for the 2018-19 school year. KSHSAA membership materials will be mailed in May to building principals and superintendents of all member schools.

## **MIDDLE/JUNIOR HIGH SCHOOL AT-LARGE REPRESENTATIVE APPOINTED TO BOARD OF DIRECTORS**
