ADMINISTRATIVE REPORTS AND UPDATES

The Board heard reports from Executive Director Gary Muselman and the Assistant Executive Directors regarding the status of programs and services of the Association. The staff reviewed fall activities which have been completed. The Executive Director gave a financial report and provided an overview of the annual report to the Kansas State Board of Education.

PROCEDURE FOR ESTABLISHING CLASSIFICATION OF SCHOOLS UPDATED

In 1994, The Executive Board established a procedure to address the annual classification of schools and addressed the need to reclassify schools as a result of incorrect reporting of a school's enrollment which resulted in the need to revise and republish corrected school classifications that year. Given the changes in technology used in establishing and publishing school classifications today, it was felt the 1994 procedure needed updating.

With that in mind, the Executive Board adopted the following procedure for establishing school classifications and making corrections in the event of reporting errors:

1. Schools are required to submit their enrollment count to the KSHSAA on the date established by the Kansas State Board of Education; this date being September 20. Should September 20 fall on Saturday or Sunday, the information will be submitted the following Monday. The information shall be submitted and signed by the principal.
2. Member schools may update this information by telephone or electronic communication ~~fax~~ the following 2 ½ working days.
3. At noon on the 3rd working day, ~~classifications will be established and sent to all member high schools~~ KSHSAA staff will begin establishing school classifications.
- ~~4. After this list is established, classifications are final.~~
4. Once classifications are completed, they will be distributed to all member senior high schools and shall be final.

Exception: Following publication, if an error by a school incorrectly places another school in a higher classification above where it should be classified, classifications will be re-established and a \$250 \$100 fine will be assessed to the school that erred.

DEBATE BALLOT PRICE CHANGE APPROVED

The staff provided a cost analysis on the production and shipping costs of the NCR form debate ballots which are made available for purchase by member schools. Following the report and discussion, the Executive Board approved increasing the cost of debate ballots from twenty cents to thirty cents each, effective immediately.

NANCY WEISHAAR TO BE HONORED WITH NFHS AWARD FOR OUTSTANDING SERVICE

Mr. Musselman announced to the Executive Board that the KSHSAA will honor Nancy Weishaar of Valley Falls with its annual NFHS Award for Outstanding Service. Mrs. Weishaar is in her forty-fifth year serving on the KSHSAA staff as registrar of officials in all sports offered by the Association. She becomes the fifth Kansan to be honored by the KSHSAA with the award which recognizes long-standing service to a state association and significant impact on high school activity programs. As registrar for all sports officials, she is responsible for maintaining registration information for more than five-thousand men and women annually, who serve Kansas schools. The Executive Board went on record commending Mrs. Weishaar for her dedication and thanking her for her long standing commitment to the KSHSAA, Kansas schools, officials and students who benefit from her service.

EXECUTIVE SESSION

KSHSAA Legal counsel, Randall Forbes, was present to meet with the Executive Board. At 11:05 a.m. a motion by Hart to enter executive session for 30 minutes for the purpose of communications subject to attorney client privilege and potential litigation was seconded by R. Perez and approved unanimously. At 11:35 a.m. Crouch made a motion to reenter open session with second by Hart. Motion was approved unanimously. At 11:38 a.m. motion by Hart, second by Gonzales to reenter executive session for 15 minutes for the purpose of communications subject to attorney client privilege and potential litigation. The motion was approved unanimously. At 11:53 a.m. Hart moved to reenter open session, second by R. Perez and the motion was approved unanimously.

RULE 30 CHANGE REGARDING USE OF SCHOOL OWNED FOOTBALL HELMETS REFERRED TO THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS

The Executive Board continued its analysis and discussion of **Seasons of Activities Rule 30**, regarding the use of school owned football helmets in non-school football activities such as all-star games, summer contact football camps conducted by colleges and 7-on-7 football activities. After extensive discussion at this meeting and their previous meeting in September,

the Executive Board voted unanimously to refer the following proposed rule change to the April agenda for final action by the KSHSAA Board of Directors. It was noted that in 2009-10, the current rule was last changed allowing schools to make their own decision regarding use of school owned football helmets in all-star games and contact camps. At that time 7-on-7 football activities were somewhat rare and were not included in that change. If the proposal (see below) is adopted by the Board of Directors, this rule change would allow schools to make their own decision regarding the use of school owned football helmets in all non-school football activities.

Rule 30

Seasons of Activities

Section 1: General Regulations (apply to grades 7-12)

Art. 6: No school-organized spring or summer practice or school-organized summer camps, shall be permitted. (See *Rule 20-1-1e, Awards.*)

d. School uniforms or player equipment may not be used.

Exception: Use of school owned football helmets in non-school, football activities is permitted with prior approval of the school administration at the school coach's non-contact, one-week camp is permitted with school approval.

KSHSAA "GAMEDAY" CHEERLEADING SHOWCASE COMPETITION

KSHSAA Spirit activities administrator, Craig Manteuffel, reported to the Board on final preparations for the KSHSAA "Gameday" Cheerleading Showcase scheduled for Saturday, November 18, 2017 in Topeka at the Kansas Expocentre. The KSHSAA is partnering with Varsity Spirit to conduct the com-

petition based on the "Gameday" format. The KSHSAA has contracted with Varsity for more than three decades to assist in providing spirit camps and spirit spreader clinics. Varsity is the nationally recognized industry leader in their field in the interscholastic athletics community. Mr. Manteuffel reported that 83 schools and 1,424 student athletes will be competing in six classifications.

2018 STATE WRESTLING TOURNAMENT CHAMPIONSHIP FINALS TO FEATURE NEW FORMAT

Assistant Executive Director, Mark Lentz, presented a state wrestling championship finals format proposal that has gained increasing interest in recent years among coaches and athletic directors. Mr. Lentz proposed the order of matches in only the championship finals round on Saturday night, be determined by a random draw at each of the three state tournaments. The drawing would be conducted by the lead official and KSHAA representative at each site on Friday night, immediately preceding weigh-ins. Once the drawing determined which weight class would be the first match of the championship finals round, then all subsequent matches will follow in their normal progression beginning with the next weight class. The Board voted unanimously to approve the proposal for the 2018 state tournaments. Mr. Lentz will communicate with all schools participating in high school wrestling this season so they will know well in advance of the state meet and may have an opportunity to utilize a similar format in regular season competition.

SPORTS MEDICINE COMMITTEE REPORT

Brent Unruh (ATC), provided the Executive Board with a meeting summary of the October 9, 2017 meeting of the KSHSAA Sports Medicine Advisory Committee.

At the request of the SMAC, Mr. Unruh presented and the Executive Board approved publication of updated revisions to sports medicine information posted on the KSHSAA website addressing:

In addition, Mr. Unruh reported that the members of the SMAC expressed interest in the KSHSAA developing an online reporting system whereby member schools could confidentially report (HIPPA compliant) concussion data from practice and games in a sport specific manner. The Board requested Mr. Unruh provide further information at their next meeting with the intent of moving forward with the involvement of the SMAC

HEAT ACCLIMATIZATION:

A biological adaptation of the human body over time to the stresses of exercise in warm/humid conditions. Physiological adjustments that need to take place include changes to the body's heart rate, body temperature regulation and sweat rate.

WHY PROPER HEAT ACCLIMATIZATION IS IMPORTANT:

- Research indicates that periods of rest and a progressive system of early practices can reduce the incidence of exertional heat stroke in athletes.
- During the summer months exertional heat stroke is the number one reason athletes die during sport.
- The body's biological adaptations to exercise stress in the heat take time, with the first 5 days of the progressive acclimatization period being the most important.
- An increase in sweat rate is one of the most vital changes that occurs during the acclimatization period giving the body the ability to regulate temperature more efficiently thereby reducing the risk of heat stroke.

COMPONENTS RECOMMENDED FOR CONSIDERATION IN KANSAS TO IMPROVE ALIGNMENT WITH CURRENT BEST PRACTICES:**Components would apply to all fall sports.**

- Only single practices allowed the first 5 days of practice in all fall sports.
- No single practice may last longer than 3 hours. All warm-up, stretching, conditioning and weight lifting is included as part of the 3 hour limit.
- A separate walkthrough is allowed in addition to the single practice. The walkthrough cannot be longer than 1 hour and must be separated from practice by at least 3 hours of rest. A walkthrough is defined as a teaching opportunity with the athletes in which no protective equipment is worn. No physically exerting activity, including any conditioning or weight lifting, may take place during the walkthrough.
- Beginning on practice day 6, double practice sessions are allowed, but cannot be held on consecutive days. The day following a double practice day would be either a single practice day or a rest day.
- On days of multiple practices, total practice time cannot exceed 5 hours. The 3 hour maximum for any single practice still applies.
- Football only:
 - Practice days 1 and 2: Helmets only (Air and Bags permitted)
 - Practice days 3 and 4: Helmets and shoulder pads only (Days 3: Control permitted; Day 4: Thud permitted)
 - Practice day 5+: Full gear permitted (All contact levels permitted)
 - On any multiple practice day, only one practice may involve Thud or Live Action.

The above components are all currently the standard recommended best practices for proper heat acclimatization in high school athletics. These recommended best practices are based on evidence based research and supported by all sports medicine professional organizations and the National Federation of High School Associations.

Following extensive discussion and a question/answer period, it was the decision of the Executive Board to not make a league assignment for the school at this time.

Assistant Executive Director David Cherry announced his plans to retire in July of 2018. Mr. Cherry is completing his 22nd year of service to the Association in 2017-18. His educational career spans 37 years in service to Kansas schools as a classroom teacher, high school athletic director and KSHSAA Assistant Executive Director. The Executive Board went on record thanking Mr. Cherry for his exemplary work, dedication and service to the member schools of the KSHSAA as well as the youth of Kansas.
