## INFORMATION ONLY

Per **Bylaws, Article VI, Powers and Duties of the Executive Board, Section 1h**, the Executive Board designates the duties of the Executive Director and adopts regulations necessary for the effective operation of the office. One of the duties delegated to the Executive Director is to handle and process certain violations. The Executive Board asked that a synopsis of some of these be listed in the Minutes as “case book” studies for the member schools to follow in applying the specific rules or policies identified.

**Qualifications of Coaches, Rule 10-1-6:** A member school withheld its’ head football coach from the first team practice for conducting football specific drills after the allowable date under the new summer coaching contact rules.

**Qualifications of Coaches, Rule 10-1-6:** A member school issued a reprimand to its’ head softball coach for coaching a non-school summer team, prior to the Saturday preceding Memorial Day.

**Seasons of Activities Rule 30-1-6 (a – 3):** A member school received an administrative reprimand and also reprimanded the head football coach, for allowing players to use helmets and shoulder pads during the one week coach’s summer team camp.

**Seasons of Activities Rule 30-1-6:** A member school, its’ administration and members of the football coaching staff, received an administrative reprimand from the KSHSAA for allowing use of school owned transportation as the means of travel to a contact football camp.

### 2008-09 AUDIT REPORT APPROVED

Mr. Musselman presented the Executive Board members with the annual certified audit report prepared by Wendling, Noe, Nelson, & Johnson L.L.C. of Topeka. Following Mr. Musselman’s review of the audit, the Board voted unanimously to accept the audit and directed staff to publish it in the October 2009 issue of the *KSHSAA Activities Journal*.

## 2009-10 BUDGET APPROVED

Following a hearing on **Wednesday, September 16, 2009 at 1 p.m.** in the KSHSAA office, the Executive Board unanimously approved the KSHSAA budget for the 2009-10 school year and authorized its publication and distribution to the member schools. The budget will be published in the November issue of the *Activities Journal*. Details concerning the chart of accounts listed are available upon request.

## UPDATE ON GIRLS’ GYMNASTICS

Assistant Executive Director Cheryl Gleason provided the Board with data on the number of schools and students participating in girls’ gymnastics this fall. Ms. Gleason recently completed the two rules meetings for head coaches and officials. Her information indicates 13 member schools are participating in the sport of girls’ gymnastics and a total of 146 gymnasts are competing. Board members were informed there has been a small increase in the number of individuals registering to serve as judges.

Member schools are reminded Executive Board policy is to continue offering state competition in gymnastics provided there are nine (9) or more schools competing. At the point in time when fewer than nine (9) schools participate, the Association’s practice is to discontinue a state championship series.

## BLUE VALLEY NORTH SWIMMING REQUEST

Blue Valley North High School Athletic Director Mickey Masterson and swimming and diving coach Derek Berg appeared to request consideration of modification to distances in selected events for an invitational swimming and diving competition. Blue Valley North High School would like to offer one modified invitational meet during the upcoming 2009-10 swimming and diving season. The meet would permit swimmers in selected events to compete in greater distances than the traditional high school list of events permits. Mr. Cherry provided the Board members with information from the National Federation High School swimming and diving rules which grants state associations authority to modify events during regular season competition for invitational meets. Based on NFHS swimming and diving Rule 5-1-1, the Executive Board voted to approve the request for one meet in both girls and boys competition in the 2009-10 school year. The Board placed the following conditions on the meet:

1. It is approved for one year only.
2. It must be offered during both the boys and girls seasons.
3. It is open to participation by Kansas schools only.
4. Entries in the 1,000 meter freestyle event will be limited to those athletes who have met qualifying time standards in the interest of safety.

## WHITE APPROVED AS THE OFFICIAL COLOR FOR ALL VOLLEYBALL COMPETITION IN 2010-11

Assistant Executive Director Cheryl Gleason provided a presentation to the Executive Board explaining the NFHS rule change permitting the use of a colored paneled volleyball effective with the 2010-11 school year. After discussing the many options available and costs associated with the change, the Board voted unanimously to require use of a white volleyball in all regular season competition and post-season tournaments in the 2010-11 school year. Member schools are reminded all game balls used in KSHSAA competition must carry the NFHS authenticating mark.

## WICHITA-COLLEGIATE HIGH SCHOOL REQUESTS LEAGUE AFFILIATION HEARING

Superintendent Tom Davis, Principal Chris Ashbrook and Athletic Director Mitch Fiegel of Wichita-Collegiate High School appeared before the Executive Board a second time, requesting the Association assign their school to a league per **Bylaw ARTICLE XV, League Affiliation**, which reads as follows:

**Section 1:** Any member school not a member of a league or similar organization may apply to the KSHSAA Executive Board for assistance in acquiring league affiliation.

**Section 2:** The Board of Directors of the KSHSAA shall develop procedures whereby: (1) the requesting school shall submit sufficient evidence to the Executive Board that it has made a conscientious effort to become affiliated with an existing league; (2) if it appears that the Executive Board may take affirmative action on the request, the requesting school and any league to which the school may be assigned shall have an opportunity to be heard by the Executive Board prior to the time the assignment is made; (3) the Executive Board, after considering all the facts in the matter, may assign the school to an existing league; (4) in the event a school is assigned to a league under the above-mentioned circumstances, no members shall withdraw from that league for a period of three years without unanimous consent of all members of the league including the newly-assigned school, or approval of the Executive Board.

Collegiate High School presented information to the Executive Board outlining their history as member of the Mid-Central Activities Association and developments which resulted in the league restructuring following the 2009-10 school year. At the request of the Executive Board, information was reviewed detailing unsuccessful efforts by the school to pursue league membership in various leagues on repeated occasions.

It was the decision of the Executive Board to schedule a hearing on this request at 10:00 a.m. on Wednesday, September 23, 2009 at the USD #259 Focht Instructional Support Center located at 412 S. Main in Wichita, Kansas. The Executive Board voted to have the members of the Ark Valley-Chisholm Trail League, Central Plains League, and the ten schools of the newly formed Central Kansas League appear for purposes of this possible league assignment hearing. It was noted, these leagues have similar sized high schools in their membership and most of their member schools are in the approximate geographic area of Wichita-Collegiate.

## ARBITER OFFICIATING SOFTWARE PROPOSAL

Marc Haught, Maize, Brent Jones, Towanda-Circle, and Curtis Conrad, Goddard, representing the Ark Valley/Chisholm Trail League schools, presented a proposal for statewide implementation of the Arbiter Officiating assignment software. It is noted approximately one-third of the leagues or league commissioners assigning officials throughout the state currently use the software. The AVCTL proposal seeks to have the KSHSAA assume the financial costs associated with registering officials in the system thereby providing all leagues and member schools access to the assignment capabilities of the program. Following discussion, it was agreed KSHSAA staff will continue to research the costs and other ramifications of the proposal, and will report back to the Board with their findings.

## SOFTBALL 43 FOOT PITCHING DISTANCE EFFECTIVE IN 2010-11

Assistant Executive Director Francine Martin reviewed for the Board, the status of the recent NFHS rule change establishing the pitching distance for high school softball at 43 feet in lieu of the current 40 foot distance. The new 43 foot rule becomes effective in the 2010-11 school year. Based on feedback gathered by the KSHSAA during last year's softball rules meetings, Kansas will not implement this rule change earlier than the date established by the NFHS. Accordingly, the pitching distance for the upcoming season will remain at 40 feet.

## STRATEGIC PLANNING COMMITTEE WORK APPROVED BY EXECUTIVE BOARD

Mr. Musselman provided the Executive Board with three items created during the two day meeting of the KSHSA strategic planning committee last June. Twenty-nine individuals from throughout the state served on the committee which also involved members of the student advisory team as well as staff. Dr. Marty Hickman, Executive Director of the Illinois High School Association, served as the facilitator for the group. After two days of extensive discussion and analysis, the committee produced three items for consideration by the Executive Board. After reviewing the mission statement, belief statements, and strategies for future consideration as created by the committee, the Executive Board voted unanimously to approve the documents. Mr. Musselman was directed to incorporate these materials into plans for the upcoming October Regional Administrator and Board of Education member meetings so the membership may become more familiar with them and participate in a discussion determining next steps to be taken.

Each of the items generated by the committee and approved by the Executive Board are printed in their entirety below:

### **Mission Statement:**

The Kansas State High School Activities Association (KSHSAA) serves students by providing leadership for the administration of education based interscholastic activities.

### **Belief Statements:**

1. Member schools are the Kansas State High School Activities Association (KSHSAA).

2. The KSHSAA is a student-centered organization.
3. The KSHSAA is the recognized state authority on interscholastic activity programs.
4. Our Association is strengthened by equity and diversity.
5. Each school choosing membership in the KSHSAA is equally important and has a direct voice in governing the organization.
6. KSHSAA is best governed by representatives of the member schools and its affiliated organizations.
7. Each KSHSAA sponsored activity is equally important.

**WRESTLING – TIE-BREAKER  
CRITERIA APPROVED**

Assistant Executive Director Rick Bowden provided the Executive Board with the results of a survey of Kansas wrestling coaches on the topic of placement of wrestlers if they have had five matches in a day during tournament competition. It had been reported many member schools were experiencing frustration when ties were unable to be broken due to the fact that one or both wrestlers had already competed in the maximum number of matches allowable under NHFS rules (5). As a result, there is no consistent way to determine how to handle the awarding of medals and distribution of points in these situations. Based on the input of coaches and feedback from the wrestling Weight Management Study Committee, the following criteria were approved unanimously by the Executive Board.

The criteria would only be used if both wrestlers were in situations where their match would be the sixth match for both wrestlers that day. If one wrestler had only four matches by

NFHS rules (matches and forfeits count) and their opponent had five (matches and forfeits), then the match would be awarded to the wrestler with only four matches.

The tie-breaking criteria are:

1. If the two wrestlers had wrestled each other in that day's competition, the results of that match would determine the awarding of places.
2. If the two wrestlers had wrestled in that day a common opponent, the results of those matches would determine the awarding of places. (*Ex: A and B both have had five matches in the tournament. A and B both wrestled C in that day's competition. C defeated A and C was defeated by B. B would be awarded the higher place.*)
3. The wrestler whose opponent has been penalized during that day's competition for unsportsmanlike conduct shall be awarded the higher place.
4. The wrestler whose opponent has been penalized during that day's competition the greater number of penalty points shall be awarded the higher place.
5. The wrestler having accumulated the greater number of falls during that day's competition shall be awarded the higher place.
6. The wrestler having accumulated the greater number of technical falls during that day's competition shall be awarded the higher place.
7. The wrestler having accumulated the greater number of points during that day's competition shall be awarded the higher place.
8. In the event the criteria does not determine which wrestler is awarded the match, both wrestlers will be awarded the same place and team points will be split between the two wrestlers.

## DISCUSSION ON PANDEMIC FLU

Mr. Musselman asked members of the Executive Board to engage in a discussion regarding the potential disruption for school activities by the H1N1 flu. Board members agreed with the current position of the KSHSAA which is to not provide direction to schools or impose specific mandates at this time. When the Association has been contacted regarding this issue, the response has been to advise that the Kansas Department of Health and Environment and local county health departments are the appropriate agencies to work with schools in regard to their plans and actions to deal with influenza outbreaks. The Board indicated their support for that position and directed Mr. Musselman to continue in that mode until circumstances dictate a different course of action might be necessary.

- b. A student may not represent a school in both singles and doubles matches.

**Art. 7:** ~~In classification groups of 33 or more schools, the regional winners of first, second, third and fourth places in both singles and doubles shall qualify for the sub-state series. The sub-state winners of first, second, third, and fourth places in both singles and doubles shall qualify for the state tournament series.~~

- a. No school may be represented by more than two contestants in the singles matches and not more than two teams in the doubles matches.
- b. A student may not represent a school in both singles and doubles matches.

Following the four presentations and extensive discussion, it was voted 5-2 to assign Wichita Collegiate High School to the Ark Valley Chisholm Trail League effective in the 2010-11 school year. The member schools of the AVCTL will determine which division of their league will assume Wichita Collegiate.

There being no other business to conduct, the meeting was adjourned.
