**Tournament Date: Thursday March 3, 2022.** Boys will bowl in the morning and girls will bowl in the afternoon.

**PLEASE NOTE:** The girls and the boys competitions are separate bowling tournaments per KSHSAA regulations. Separate admission will be charged for each one. Please inform all spectators that separate admission is charged for each session. Admission from the morning session will not be honored for the afternoon session. Northrock lanes will close about 11:30 a.m. and all spectators, coaches, and athletes will be required to leave. Pass gate and ticket sales will reopen/resume at 12:30 pm for the girl's tournament.

<b>Entries</b>	Submit <b>BWL-5 (Boys)</b> and/or <b>BWL-6 (Girls)</b> online to KSHSAA Monday, February 28. Please refer to KSHSAA Bowling Manual Page 34 for instructions. Teams will be placed according to regional finishes. Coach determines team pair. Indicate on form. Also indicate any bowler who bowled a 300 game in competition this year
<b>Practice time</b>	Please contact Northrock at <a href="mailto:events@northrocklanes.com">events@northrocklanes.com</a> to make arrangements for team/individual practice times prior to the state tournament. By securing a practice time, you will only be charged \$20.00 per lane per hour. Practice times will be available by reservation for local schools (and those capable of traveling) Monday through Wednesday. Thursday, there will be a few lanes available late afternoon/evening, and all 48 lanes available after 9:00 PM. Call and make reservations. You must pay cash or credit card. Northrock is not able to bill schools.
<b>Pass Gate</b>	The pass gate will be located at the north entrance at Northrock. Only those listed on <b>BWL-5 (Boys)</b> and/or <b>BWL-6 (Girls)</b> will be admitted free at pass gate. All on Pass List <b>MUST</b> use north most entrance. State qualifiers will be admitted at no cost to the other tournaments <b>IF ACCOMPANIED BY THEIR COACH. Assemble together and enter as a team.</b> Managers will be free and will receive a stamp but may not sit in the settee area.
<b>Form TRA</b>	6A schools, please scan and email KSHSAA Form TRA (Travel Form) to Russell Baldwin at <a href="mailto:rbaldwin@usd260.com">rbaldwin@usd260.com</a> . In the event tournament must be postponed due to weather, the 6A tournament will be reschedule for Monday and Tuesday March 7 and 8.
<b>Banners</b>	Please make arrangements for your banner to be delivered to Northrock by Thursday evening. These banners will be on display at the championship tournament. <b>Please pick up your banner at the conclusion of the tournament.</b>
<b>Admission</b>	<b>Separate admissions charged for morning and afternoon sessions.</b> \$9.00 adults \$6.00 students (K-12) <b>Per KSHSAA policy: SAVING SEATS FOR OTHERS IS NOT PERMITTED.</b>
<b>Introductions</b>	Please see times listed above. All participants (athletes and coaches) will be introduced in order by lane assignment and team starting with individual qualifiers and team assigned to lowest numbered lanes. Individuals first assigned to lanes 1-14. Multiples from the same school will be put together, then the 6 individuals and the 2 teams on 17-22, followed by 3 teams on 25 – 30 and 3 on 33-38 and 3 on 41-46. This will enable team/individuals to be in front of their fans for introductions. Please have all individual qualifiers and teams present for these introductions.
<b>Lane Assignments</b>	Lane assignments will be made by the KSHSAA and will be posted on their web site ( <a href="http://www.kshsaa.org">www.kshsaa.org</a> ). Please see page 35 of the KSHSAA 2021 - 2022 KSHSAA Bowling Manual for additional information.
<b>Photo Area</b>	You are able to take photos in front of the KSHSAA State Championships banner located in the room next to the concession stand, north of the entrance. This area will be available for pictures during the scheduled hours of each girls and boys competitions of the state tournament.
<b>Awards</b>	The top twenty individual finishers for both boys and girls will receive medals; the top three teams for both boys and girls will receive trophies, and the members of the top three teams will receive medals (7 team medals). Ties will be broken per guidelines pages 21-22 of KSHSAA Bowling Manual.

<b>Results</b>	Each school is asked to provide a runner or coach to submit scores for your school after each game is completed for the match on the designated score form provided at the coaches meeting. By submitting these scores, meet management will be able to score the event more quickly.
<b>Competition area</b>	Please inform your fans, spectators, and parents that only the bowlers and coaches with a wristband will be allowed in the competition area. Team members must be seated when not bowling. Each team may have no more than two coaches ( <b>no managers</b> ) in the competition area at one time. <b>Chairs in lower level behind the team are reserved for your female bowlers in the morning and male bowlers in the afternoon and they are not to be moved. There is to be no standing in the competition area except for the bowler in American Tenpin. During Bakers, coaches and teammates of the gender bowling will be allowed to stand.</b>
<b>Substitutions</b>	Entries are final as of 10 AM Tuesday, March 1. Team substitutions may be allowed in an emergency situation only with the approval of the tournament manager. There will be no substitutions for individual qualifiers.
<b>Arbitration Committee</b>	Will be established per KSHSAA guidelines: One coach from each regional, Brent Bowers, Northrock Lanes, and Russell Baldwin (6A Tournament manager).
<b>Hospitality Room</b>	A hospitality room will be provided, compliments of Northrock Lanes. This room is open for coaches, administrators, and event workers only. Please, no parents or student-athletes. The room used for the coaches meeting and hospitality will be closed between the girls and the boys tournaments. Room will be used to provide lunch for the workers. Coaches and school administrators are welcome to purchase lunch in AJ's Sports Grill.
<b>State Bowling Shirts</b>	Official KSHSAA State Championship Bowling Tournament shirts will be sold at the event. Athletes are encouraged to purchase early, as they tend to sell out of certain sizes/styles quickly. The cost is \$19 for S/S — \$23 for L/S — \$33 for Hoodies
<b>Programs</b>	Will be on sale for \$3 each.
<b>Parking</b>	We ask that teams that will be arriving with school vehicles/buses park behind the bowling center. This will leave more room up front and on each side of Northrock Bowling Center.
<b>No Outside Food or Drink</b>	No outside food or drink may be brought into Northrock Lanes. Teams are asked to support the bowling proprietors and not bring in outside food and drink (including bottled water). <b>Teams can bring their own cases of water. NO GATORADE OR SUGAR DRINKS! NO COOLERS WILL BE ADMITTED.</b> Please support AJ's Sports Grill and Northrock Concession stand.
<b>Handicap Seating</b>	Handicap seating is limited and will be handled on a case-by-case basis by KSHSAA and Tournament Manager. Please contact KSHSAA Bowling Administrator Annie Diederich <u>in ADVANCE</u> , if you know that special accommodations are needed.
<b>Noisemakers/Signs</b>	Noisemakers are not allowed in the Bowling Center. Signs that are in good taste that do not block the view of the other spectators, at the discretion of the tournament manager may be allowed.
<b>Cell Phones/Electronic Devices</b>	Athletes may not be in possession of or use cell phones/electronic devices in the competition area. Spectators are asked to place cell phones on vibrate or turn off in the immediate spectator seating area. Please refer to page 28 in the Bowling Manual.

## **Flash Photography/Pictures**

**Flash photography is not permitted during competition.** Picture taking opportunities will be available during and after the awards ceremony.
