WARM-UP:

We are asking that players are not on the practice green or driving range more than 45 minutes before their starting time. Range balls will be purchased by the school prior to the first day of play. Range balls will be set on the driving range in pyramids and baskets available for all teams/players who have purchased range balls prior. Teams who do not pay prior will be allowed to purchase range balls that morning in the pro shop.

PRACTICE ROUNDS:

Practice rounds are available Friday, Oct. 14th- Sunday, Oct. 16th. Price will be \$20 walking or \$30 with a cart (carts are limited and can not be guaranteed). This price is good for all players and coaches. Please call to reserve your time and indicate what school you are with and that you are playing a practice round! (620)327-2331. Saturday & Sunday times start after 1:00pm. Only the driving range/putting green will be available on the day of the tournament

CELL PHONES:

Players may have their cell phones on them but can only be used to contact a Rules Official! All other uses of cell phones will result in a disqualification!

WARM-UP:

We are asking that players are not on the practice green or driving range more than 45 minutes before their starting time. Cost is \$6.00/player for driving range balls per day.

SPECTATORS / GALLERIES:

Spectators will be allowed as long as they adhere to the enclosed spectator guidelines. Golf carts are available for \$40.00 per day and are bought on a first come first served basis both days via call-in or in person. Your rental on day 1 DOES NOT guarantee you a cart for day 2.

You will have to purchase a cart both days. A single individual is limited to two cart rentals. Starting at 8:00am on the day following the 5A regional competitions, spectators may call the pro shop at 620-327-2331 to reserve a golf cart (must pay over the phone). NO REFUNDS!

PARKING:

The parking lot at Hesston Golf Course will be available until it is full. After the lot is full, we will direct all additional parking to Hobbs Stadium at Hesston High School. **We do not allow parking along the drive**. There will be a shuttle service for those that need transportation. We encourage carpooling as much as possible to help the parking situation.

STATE CHAMPIONSHIP TEE SHIRTS:

Tee shirts will be sold on site. No checks will be accepted, will be cash or credit card only.

We will have starters, rules officials and spotters on the course.
