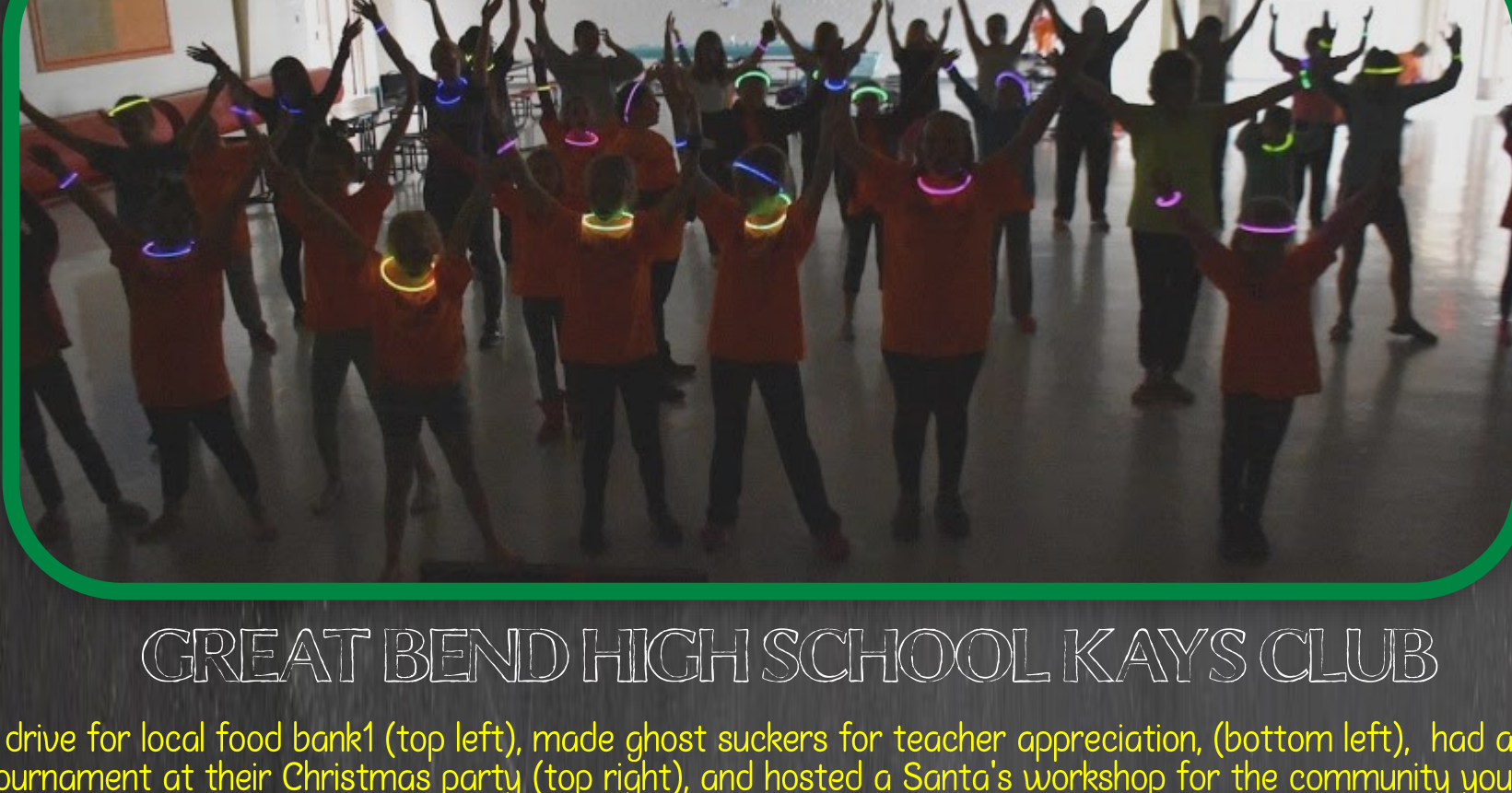
## GODDARD HIGH SCHOOL KAY CLUB
