WHAT IS 988?

The 988 Lifeline is a national network of local crisis centers that provides free and confidential emotional support to people in need including those in suicidal crisis or emotional distress. The line is available 24 hours a day, 7 days a week in the United States.

PROGRAM OPPORTUNITIES

Participation in *Thriving Youth* projects is not required but does provide KAY clubs with many valuable lessons and experiences. Each club has the opportunity to EARN \$100 for participating in at least 2 PROJECTS during the school year that are targeted at one or both of these topics.

Clubs may either create their own projects or actively support an existing project the school has to support education on 988 and the dangers of vaping. The report submitted must show how the club led or actively engaged in the project.

Clubs must obtain any required permission from their school administration.
