Some considerations in judging Original Oration:

Content

- A. Is the subject matter intrinsically worthwhile?
- B. Is the approach fresh, original in its concept and free of stereotyped clichés?

Organization

- A. Does the speaker present the introduction and conclusion in an adequate manner?
- B. Does the speaker use an appropriate organizational pattern?
- C. Does the speaker make his/her points and transitions in an adequate manner?

Diction

- A. Is the language of the speech appropriate, communicative and forceful?
- B. Is the voice pleasant, distinct and responsive?
- C. Does the speaker employ proper pronunciation and effective enunciation?

Delivery

- A. Is the speaker sincere, direct, animated and persuasive?
- B. Is there an absence of distracting gestures, quirks and mannerisms?
- C. Is the speech itself delivered in the best accepted manner of oratory?

Time Limit: If an official timekeeper is present, any performance in excess of the 15-second grace period shall not receive the "I" ranking in the round. Any performer(s) exceeding 30 seconds over the time limit shall receive the lowest ranking in the round. If no official timekeeper is present, no penalty shall be enforced. THE JUDGE SHALL NOT SERVE AS OFFICIAL TIMEKEEPER.

Participant's Information: Please remember that the sections of your ballot do not carry equal weight. Each judge is allowed to determine the percentage evaluation of each section.
