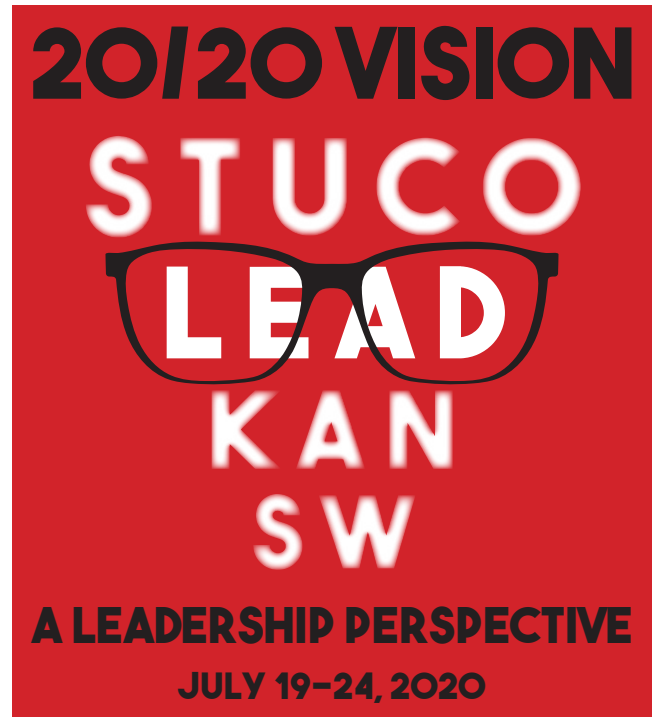
July 23 (Day 5) = "What STUCO Means to Us!"

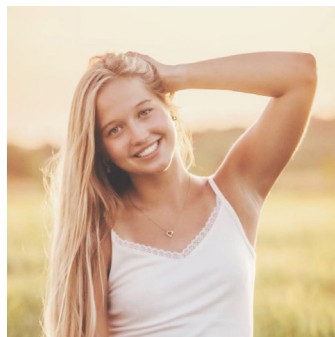
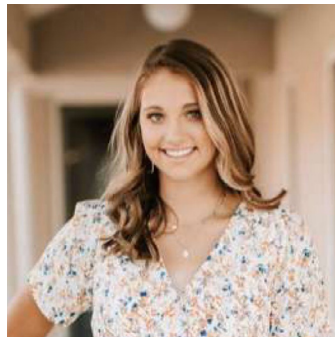
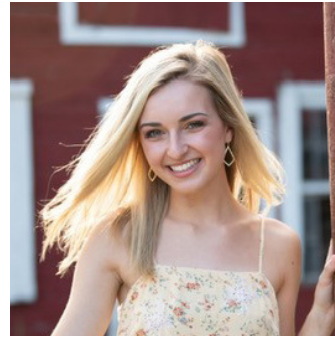
July 24 (Day 6) = "Staying Motivated During the Unknown"
