DEFAULTS – NEW RULES

Defaults will be treated as a loss and will be used in seeding processes (only for directs and NOT for indirects). The athlete will not be eligible to participate in the remainder of the tournament. If the default is determined to be a medical default by a medical advisory team (coach, tournament manager, onsite medical personnel), the medical default will not be counted in seeding. If the athlete is cleared and determined healthy enough to continue play by the medical advisory team, the athlete may do so. Retired matches will be used in seeding (only as a direct). REMINDER(S):

ENTERING WIN/LOSS RECORDS

Coaches are expected to enter win(s)/loss(es) within 48 hours of competition. There are additional options when entering tennis scores this year regarding defaults/medical defaults/medical retirement. Accurate and updated information is essential to the seeding process for postseason. Please ensure this information is being entered throughout the season – this is a communication piece between coaches and ADs.
