### **Regional Tennis Week**

The time is here, and we are ready to host regional tennis across the state starting on Friday, October 6, 2023, and ending on Saturday, October 7, 2023. If you are a regional host, please ensure that your online bracket is completely updated, including the team scoring and qualifiers tabs as soon as possible following the conclusion of your tournament. Additionally, with the new seeding procedures, coaches of ALL state qualifiers need to update these athlete's win/loss reports with regional matches. Please have this completed by 6 pm on Sunday, October 8, 2023, so that information can be prepared for the seeding meetings on October 9 and 10. Good luck to all teams as they finish this 2023 season and move into regionals!

### **Recording of Matches**

If a singles player or a player in a doubles team is injured and cannot complete the rest of the matches for the day, the matches beyond that do not count as wins/losses and should not be recorded. Byes in the regular season are also not counted on a record. Byes are only counted in the postseason. Matches that have started but have an opponent retire during the match SHOULD be recorded in your online win-loss records. For example, 5-1 retired. These matches do count for seeding and direct or indirect wins. Matches that never started due to an entry defaulting DO NOT need to be recorded in your online win-loss records. There are many legit and non-legit reasons why a player or doubles team chooses to not play a match and default. Do not include defaults on your online-win-loss records. They do not count as direct or indirect wins for seeding consideration.

### **Win/Loss Records – Please make this a priority!**

Coaches are expected to record the competition information for their players. Be sure to record results for all regular season competition as well as regional and state competition at the end of the season. Results are archived at this location from previous years. **Records are expected to be updated by 6 pm on Sunday, October 8, 2023, to prepare for the state seeding meetings.**

Update your records by logging in on the KSHSAA website, go to “Activities” and you will find the Girls Win/Loss Report under Tennis.
