1A, 2A, & 4A State Cross Country Information

Congratulations on your team(s)/Individuals making the State Cross Country Meet for 1A, 2A, and 4A classifications. We look forward to hosting you here in Wamego on November 2, 2024. Below is information regarding the event.

- **Course:** The course is run at Wamego Country Club, 1900 Country Club Drive. With this letter is a picture of the course and route. Wamego Country Club does **NOT** allow course preview.
- **Parking:** Spectators will park at the Wamego Athletic Football Complex off of Columbian Ave, 4290 Columbian Rd. All team buses/vans will park on the shoulders of Columbian Rd. Please do not park on Highway 24.
- **Packets:** Race Day packets will be available starting at 7:00 am at the main gate of entry off of Columbian Ave. across from the football complex.

- **Coaches meeting:** There will be a short meeting near the starting line right before the start of each race. The head coach from each school must attend this meeting.
- **Admissions:** The admission price will be \$10 set by KSHSAA. Please let your families know the price.
- **Pass Gate:** Two coaches and one manager will be admitted free of charge at the pass gate. The competitors enter the course at the same pass gate. Superintendents, principals, and athletic directors in attendance will also be admitted free of charge at the pass gate. Family members of those individuals will not be free.
- **Dressing:** Dressing rooms and showers will not be available. The restrooms at the entrance to the football stadium will be open for your use.
- **Scoring:** Heartland Timing has been contracted by KSHSAA to score the championship races. Each competitor will receive a bib that has a timing chip as part of its design. A finishlynx camera and an identilyn timer video cameras will be used to place runners that are very close when crossing the finish line. The determining factor for the order of finish is the torso crossing the finish line.

- **Parents and Fans:** Parents and other fans **WILL NOT** be allowed near the finish line/trailer area. People working in the trailer will only field questions or concerns from coaches, not parents. People other than coaches will be escorted away from the area. Coaches, please share this with your parents. Thank you.
- **Pets:** Please do **NOT** bring pets onto the cross-country race area or golf course. Our admissions attendants will not allow anyone to enter with animals other than those required for handicapped assistance.
- **Awards Location:** The award presentations will be inside the sports complex stadium to take advantage of the permanent sound system. The stadium seating allows all a clear view of the individuals and teams as they receive their awards.
- **Awards:** The top 20 individuals will be awarded medals. The top 3 teams from each race will receive team plaques and team medals. Please pay attention to the award times!
- **Time on the Course:** Times will be given at the 1-mile and 2-mile marks.
- **Course markings:** A white paint line will mark the entire course. If we have inclement weather, the runners will always run between the red flag markers. *****Coaches/runners are NOT allowed to place flags or any other markers on the course.*****
- **Course Umpires:** Umpires will be stationed around the course for the purpose of identifying any runner who might intentionally take advantage by cutting or performing any unsportsmanlike act to interfere with other runners. Any runner performing an unsportsmanlike act shall be disqualified.
- **Restrooms:** We will place portable restrooms just outside the district bus lot directly west of the starting line. These can be used by anyone, but runners should be given the opportunity to go to the front of the line if their race is starting soon. Restrooms are also available at the Sports Complex football field area.
- **Jury of Appeals:** The Jury of Appeals will be assigned by KSHSAA.
- **Chute:** Workers assisting in the chute will keep runners finishing the race moving away from the finish line area. Placing is electronically determined with a FinishLynx camera and an identilynx video camera used for back-up if necessary. ****The torso crossing the finish line is the determining factor for the order of finish.****
- **Picking up Information:** WHS Cheerleaders will be handing out packets of information for all participating schools. They will include everything you will need including bib numbers and pins. If you need more pins, come to the finish line/tent area, and ask for more. These packets will be located right inside the entrance gate.
- **Uniform Rules:** Coaches were required to verify your team will be legally equipped during the regional entry submission process.
- **Concessions:** There will be a concession stand set up inside the golf course admissions area north of the finish tent.

- Fans can AVOID Cash ticket lines and purchase their tickets in advance through GoFan, the KSHSAA digital ticketing partner. The link will be available on the state cross country page of the KSHSAA website,

- Once tickets are purchased, fans have four options to retrieve their tickets for entry to the event:
 1. Through the confirmation email from GoFan
 2. Through the confirmation text from GoFan (if this option is selected at purchase)
 3. Through the <https://gofan.co/> website (if user creates an account)
 4. Through the GoFan app (Apple iOS devices only)

Fans will show their tickets at the gate on their mobile devices. The purchaser may choose to transfer some of the tickets to another user if the group is not all arriving at the same time. 
