RECORDS THROUGHOUT POSTSEASON

-Byes during the regular season DO NOT count as a win. Matches not played due to forfeiture during the regular season DO NOT count as a win.

-Only full varsity matches (all sets to 25) against varsity teams may be counted in varsity records.

Regional Record: Records for Regionals will include all eligible regular season matches played up until Sunday, October 13, 2024 by 8:00 am. This is the record that the KSHSAA will use to seed teams in Regional Quads/Tris.

Sub-State Record: Records for Sub-State will include the Regional record in addition to wins/losses accumulated during Regionals. Any regular season matches played after the seeding date will be added to a team's record upon qualifying for the State Tournament.

State Record: Records will include ALL regular season matches, Regional matches, and Sub-State matches.

Two check boxes are now available on the KSHSAA win/loss reporting page. Please mark the "Regional/Sub-State Seeding" box when records are ready for seeding on October 13. The other box should be marked when all regular season matches are complete. It is possible that you will check mark both boxes on the 13th if you have completed your regular season schedule.

My record is complete for Regional/Sub-State Seeding

Check this box when your entire regular season schedule is updated, complete and all scores recorded.

SEEDING CRITERIA

The schools in your regional will be seeded using the criteria on pages 38-39 of the 2024-2025 <u>KSHSAA Volleyball Manual</u>. Once seeded/identified, the schools will be placed into 4 regional quads/tris based on their seed.

START TIMES FOR REGIONALS AND SUB-STATE

Regional starting times will be either 4 pm or 5 pm. Host schools should work with traveling schools as well as assigned officials for the appropriate start time.

Sub-States may not start prior to 1 pm.

2A PLAY-IN MATCHES

Due to coops moving schools up to Class 2A, two regionals in Class 2A will have a play-in match for seeds 16 and 17. The match will take place at the 16 seed and will be the best of 3 set format. After seeding on Oct 13, schools will need to communicate to determine this match date prior to Monday, October 21. Results of this match must be reported to the KSHSAA immediately upon completion of the match.

REGIONAL QUAD AND TRI FORMATS

Regional quads will be played as detailed in the KSHSAA Volleyball Manual. Remember, there is a 20-minute break between the second and third matches in regional quad play unless a lesser time is mutually agreed upon by coaches.

Regional tris will be played as detailed below. There will not be a break between the second and third matches in a tri. In 1A DI, seeds 1-3 will host tris. The 4 seed will host a full quad. In 1A DII, the top 3 seeds will host a tri while the 4 seed hosts a quad while in one regional, seeds 1-4 will host tris.

REMEMBER - IMPORTANT: The qualifying schools from 1A DI and 1A DII Regional tris will receive a bye win that will count towards their postseason record. This will need to be included when reporting records for sub-state.

WARMUP

Teams will follow the KSHSAA postseason warmup (20 minute warm up, followed by a 10 minute warm up). See page 30 in the KSHSAA Volleyball Manual for details.

HOSTING REQUIREMENTS

Seeds 1-4 have the first option of hosting Regionals and/or Sub-State.

To host a Regional Quad, the host school must have two NFHS compliant courts under the same roof with adequate seating. If the school does not meet those requirements, they may host at a neutral site. If the top seed is not able to host, the next highest seed will host.

To host a Regional Tri, the host school must have one NFHS compliant court with adequate seating. If the school does not meet those requirements, they may host at a neutral site. If the top seed is not able to host, the next highest seed will host.

To host Sub-State, the host school must have one NFHS compliant court with adequate seating. If the school does not meet those requirements, they may host at a neutral site. If the top seed is not able to host, the next highest seed will host.

The distinct disadvantage policy will apply during Regionals and Sub-State. If the school has declared a distinct disadvantage for a court, teams will switch benches between sets. If no distinct disadvantage is present, teams may stay at their respective benches.

Hosts are responsible for securing trained line judges, scorekeepers, libero trackers, and scoreclock operators. Line judges will be paid by the host site (this is printed incorrectly in the KSHSAA VB Manual); the KSHSAA will pay officials through ArbiterPay. See page 49 in the KSHSAA Volleyball Manual for line judge and officials' pay rates.
